Middleton Finds Cold ---By Degrees

MIDDLETON — "What's the temperature?"
Middleton business from thermometers supply the answers.

Along two blocks on Parmenter st., there are eleven prominently displayed thermometers offering service on cold blustery mornings. Each of them offers a different temperature.

If you are feeling very cold and want a temperature that agrees with your senses, you'll find it at the green-front chain grocery. The glistening white-enamelled, red solutioned thermometer always can be counted on to report at least 6 degrees below the official temperature.

Ab, Getting Warmer
If you have taken time to breakfast properly, have worn your earmuffs, and are feeling quite warm, you'll find a temperature that will agree at the cleaners. Here a tall tube mounted on a slick yellow board offers temperatures usually a full 20 degrees above the official temperature.

At the restaurant across the street are twin thermometers, one in plain view flooded with street light; the other one hidden behind the open screen door. Together they urge you to chew a certain brand of snuff in 'summer, winter, spring, and fall'. The temperature they record is from 6 to 8 degrees below that offered by the hotel thermometers.

A highly colored thermometer on the wide door jamb of the corner tavern suggests that you drink a well known un-carbonated brand of orangeade, but leaves you undecided on the temperature. The street light throws a black shadow over the tube making it impossible to read in the morning darkness without help from a match or black out torch.

Whoops, We're Stuck
What looks like a distinguished and dependable thermometer attracts you to the telephone exchange, but turns out to be nothing more than an unpainted spot where an instrument used to hang. Rependent with a mirror and weather tube that clouds up sometimes the long tube of mercury at the furniture store vies with the plain small dial on the drugstore window for accuracy. They alone agree with each other and come

McDougall has an aluminum butter dish which he picked up in an abandoned German officers' lean-to on the Argonne front in September, 1918, when he was a signalman with the 28th division. On it is engraved the name and address of 16-year-old Lieut. Rommel, now the field marshal.
