Democrats Fear Security Fight

WASHINGTON (U.P.)—Influential Democratic congressional leaders today are trying to persuade Pres. Roosevelt to postpone asking congress for a new social security program broad enough to cover every man, woman, and child in the United States.

They fear that any proposal comparable to the British Beveridge social security plan will precipitate an "unnecessary and dangerous" dispute in the new congress.

The group is trying to talk with the president before he delivers his state of the union message, now scheduled for Thursday.

None of the congressmen is very hopeful of convincing Mr. Roosevelt that his message should be confined to the war effort, but all hoped to avoid any reference to a new social security plan.

There has been little indication of the short of social security revisions the president is planning, but it was considered almost certain that he would seek to improve the benefits of the present system and extend its coverage.

The concern of the Democratic leaders hinted that the social security issue, if presented by the president, would create a major fight in the early days of the new congress. It might be combined with Republican complaints that the administration is making too much of an effort to "nail down" what they describe as "post-war specifics" before the war is won.
