

"White Cargo" Opens Friday With Hedy Lamarr, Pidgeon

Ohio Brings Famed Film Of Romanticism, Mysticism, Struggle And Conflict

"White Cargo," a story of romanticism, mysticism, struggle and conflict, opens Friday at the Ohio theatre. Hedy Lamarr portrays a dark-skinned native who fights for the love of Walter Pidgeon who is cast as a two-fisted rubber plantation overseer. "Yankee Doodle Dandy" a film packed with music ends a long run on Thursday.

Two swell pictures—"Counter-Espionage" and "The Daring Young Man"—will open at the Quilna theatre preview Friday evening. Suave Warren William is seen in the first picture in which he helps the British Intelligence smash a Nazi spy ring in London. Laughs and thrills are plentiful in the other hit which stars Joe E. Brown.

Vast oil fields and bustling, rowdy oil towns are the locales in the State's new film, "Wildcat," which features Richard Arlen and Arline Judge. One of the most gripping mystery thrillers of the season, "Eyes in the Night," with Edward Arnold and Ann Harding, completes the program. "Top Sergeant," a fast-moving, action-packed melodrama of an underworld rat who tries to use the uniform of Uncle Sam as the perfect hideout for a murder, opens Friday at the Lyric. Hedy Lamarr appears in one of the most exciting roles in her entire screen career, teamed with Walter Pidgeon and playing the sultry jungle charmer, Tondeyayo. In "White Cargo," coming Friday to the Ohio theatre, as the fascinating mysterious native siren she captivates Richard Carlson and precipitates a stark drama of human emotions, set deep in a jungle rubber plantation in Africa.

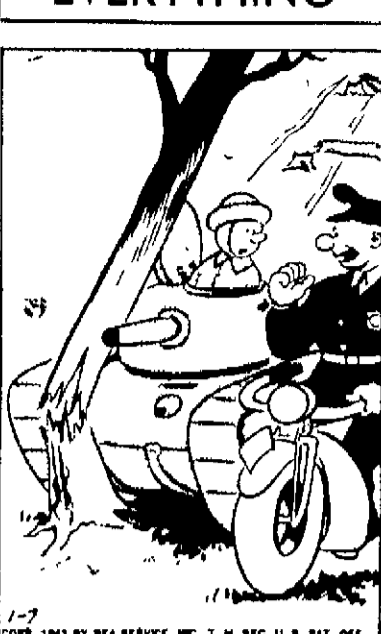
