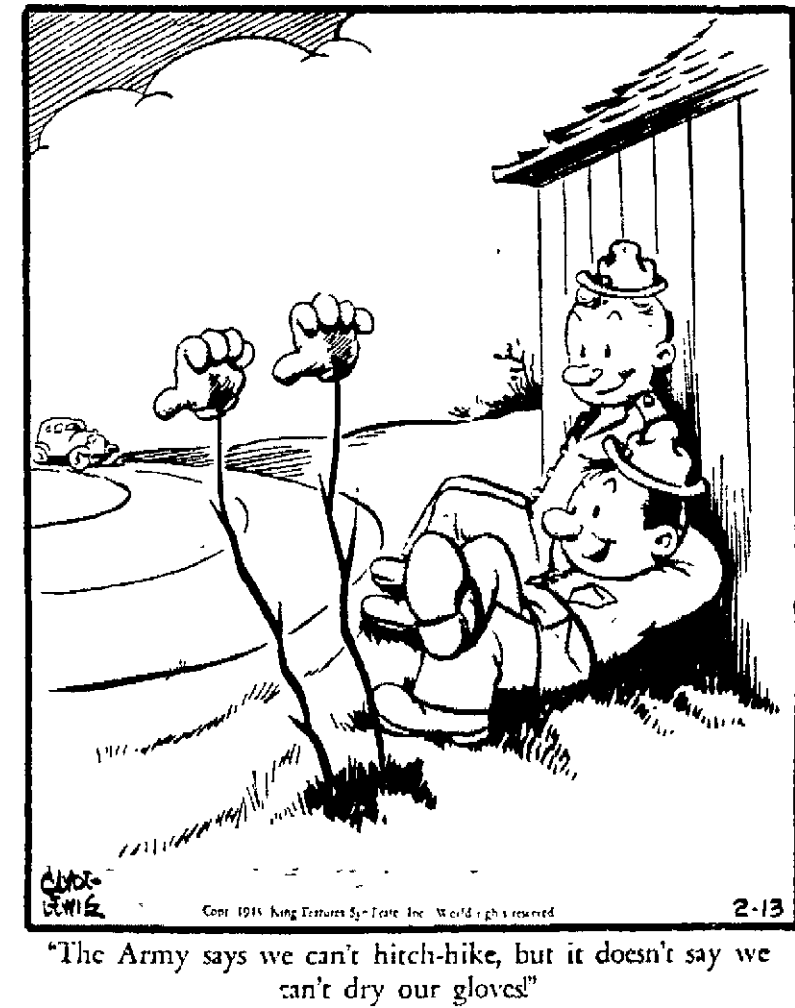

TAX COLLECTION IS STEADY AS DEADLINE NEARS

With \$41,445.88 taken in during the week just closed, real estate tax collections for the first half of 1942 totaled \$264,766.80 to date, according to Allen-co Treasurer Ray W. Barnett. The deadline for payment of December taxes will be March 6, he announced.

508 HARDIN FAMILIES ARE IN FHA PROGRAM

KENTON, Feb. 13 — Some 508 families in Hardin-co have made repairs to their properties or bought homes under the FHA program from the time it was started thru June last year, it was reported Friday by A. L. Guckert, FHA director for the central Ohio district.

This includes 444 title I-Property Improvement loans insured by FHA in Hardin-co amounting to \$126,332 and 64 Title II-Small Home mortgages accepted for an insurance amounting to \$175,600. The grand total of 508 transactions involved a sum of \$302,932.

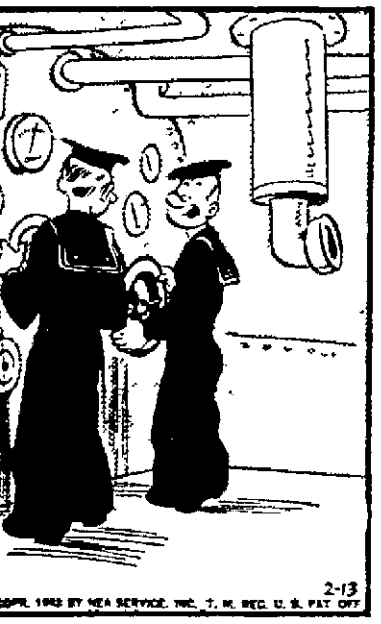

MARINE CORPS TO TAKE WOMEN

Establishment of Reserve Unit Is Announced At Cleveland

CLEVELAND, O., Feb. 13—The ranks of the Marine Corps were finally thrown open to women Saturday when the corps announced the establishment of a Women's Reserve, as authorized by Congress in an act of 1942. Members of the Reserve will be called Marines.

Nationwide enrollment of women between ages of 20 and 50 as officer candidates and 20 and 36 as enlisted personnel will begin immediately under the direction of the newly appointed director, Mrs. Ruth Cheney Streeter, joint donor of the Cheney Award to members of the Army Air Corps for acts of

valor and former chairman of Ft. Dix of the Citizens' Committee for Army and Navy, Inc., Mrs. Streeter will hold the rank of major, in the Marine Corps.

The Women's Reserve will include both commissioned officers and enlisted personnel. Ranks and pay will be the same as those for men of the Corps. It will be possible for women to work their way up thru enlisted ranks and into commissioned grades, Major Streeter said.

Applicants for officer commission must be between 20 and 50 and have a college degree or two years of college and at least two years of business experience, or special qualifications in a particular field.

Enlisted personnel must be between 20 and 36, have at least two years of high school or business school education, or special qualifications in a particular field.

Women wanting to enlist are directed to apply in writing to the Marine Corps Officers Procurement Office, Marshall Building, Public Square, Cleveland, Ohio, stating their age, educational record, occupational and marital status.
