Uncle Ray's Corner
Russians Have Solved Problems of Fast Winter Transport
By traveling, however, we usually mean getting somewhere, going from one place to another, not sliding downhill. Mounted on a swift steed, a person may make fairly good time, but at the best it takes almost two minutes for a mile. Except on the race track, a mounted man seldom covers a mile in less than three or four minutes. The power of the wind no doubt would be the best thing to use if we were without automobiles, motorcycles, steam locomotives and so on. We could employ this power while aboard balloons or gliders if they are to stay in the air very long. Certain winds have a lifting power, and that explains why an airplane glider may stay in the air for hours on end. Sailing offers a way of travel over water. Excellent winds may carry a sailboat forward at a fair-god speed. A quarter of a minute, however, is a high average for a sailboat in a long race. Ice boats are fast travelers over smooth ice in good winds. Now and then they make a speed of more than a mile a minute, far faster than any sailboat can move. In places where snow and ice thicken over the roads, it is hard to travel aboard a bicycle, motorcycle or automobile. Inventors have worked on the problem, and have solved it to a certain extent. In Russia there has been special effort in this field. The winter success of Russian armies has been due, in part, to skillful planning to meet the problems of speed in winter.
