

Marlene Dietrich Picture Opening At State Thursday

"Pittsburgh" And "Mug Town" Are Co-Featured; Lyric Brings Story Of G-Men's War On Crime

"Pittsburgh," a story of sinew and steel, is the starring vehicle of Marlene Dietrich, Randolph Scott and John Wayne scheduled to open a three-day run at the State theatre on Thursday.
