KAFFIRS DIVIDE AND BEND HORNS OF YOUNG CATTLE

The African buffalo, of which we spoke yesterday, usually can whip a lion. Many fights between lions and buffaloes have taken place in southern Africa, and usually the lions have lost. The lions may win, however, if two or three of them attack a single buffalo, apart from its herd.

While speaking of African buffaloes, we may note that they are distant relatives of the buffaloes or bison of our continent. They are not, however, humpbacked, like the American bison.

Efforts to domesticate the African buffalo have failed. In this way it is very different from the Indian water buffalo, which has been a beast of burden in southern Asia for thousands of years.
