The firm made a listener's survey of the best 110 network radio programs and the report shows that the Fibber McGee and Molly program tops them all. Others in order in the top ten were Red Skelton, Bob Hope, Charlie McCarthy, The Aldrich Family, Walter Winchell, Maxfield House, Time, Mr. District Attorney, Jack Benny, and the Radio Theater.

Checking the report further, WIBA can also claim 14 out of the first 20, 27 out of the first 50, and 44 out of the rated list of 110.
