Death stalks a young American from one European country to another, but is eventually outwitted by the cleverness of the victim in Orson Welles' "Journey Into Fear," due Wednesday at the Sigma.

Tense drama alternates with sparkling comedy in Leo McCarey's "Once Upon a Honey-moon," due Wednesday at the State starring Ginger Rogers and Cary Grant.

All who have seen "Hello, Frisco, Hello," Quilna technicolor hit, have hailed it one of the best pictures of this year.

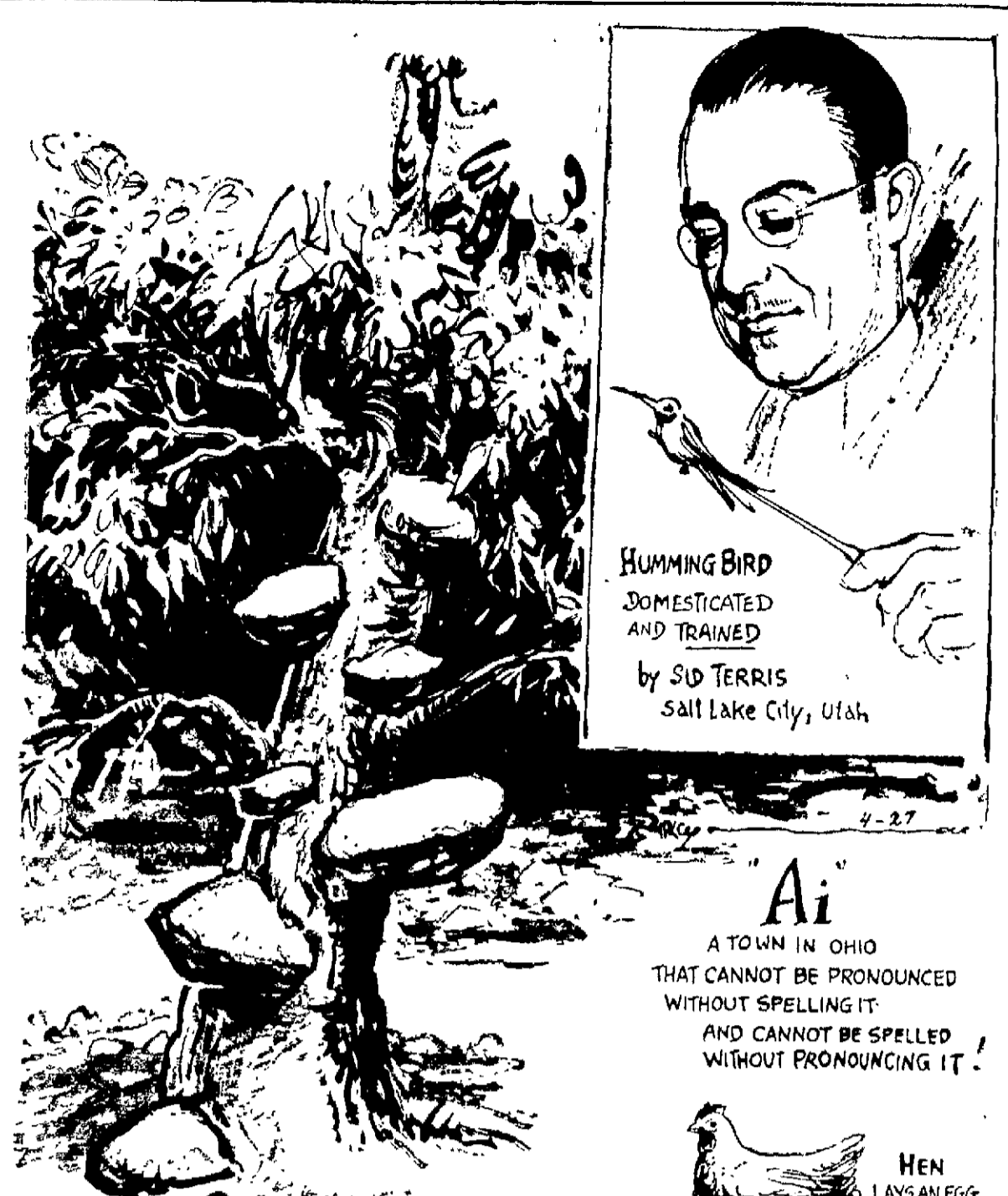
