INDIANAPOLIS FIRM BUYS WAPAK PLANT

(Lima News Bureau) WAPAKONETA, May 11—Sale of the local branch factory of the Degraff Food Co., formerly known as the Macke Canning Co. of Indianapolis, Ind., was announced today by E. G. Thatcher, manager of the Degraff Food Co.

Thatcher also disclosed the sale of another canning factory at Columbus Grove which for the past several years has been operated by his concern. Both the local plant and the Columbus Grove plant are to be operated under the name of the Lutz Canning Co., which also has plants in Arcanum and Defiance.

Paul Ehrler and Garnet Amic will remain in charge of the local plant. Officials of the new company have not made any statements as to operating plans of the local plant which in the past year solely confined activities to the canning of tomatoes.
