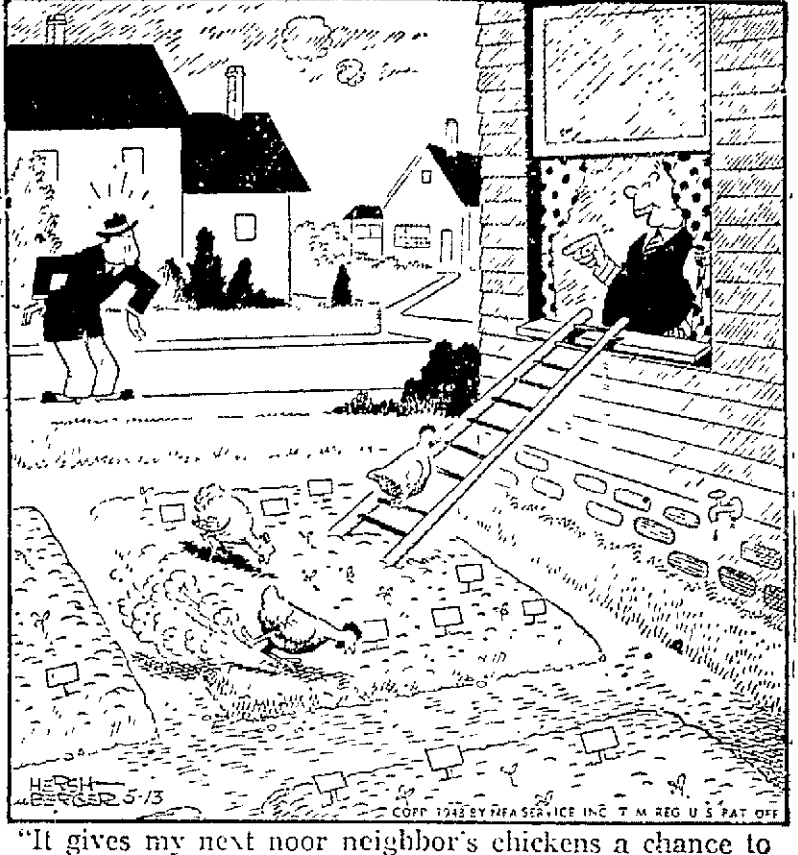

Renewals For Gas Rations Being Taken

Applications for renewal of gasoline rations are being received by the Rationing Board from Lima and Allonco residents in large numbers.

Board officials made this announcement Thursday as they expressed satisfaction with the operation of the "mail box" method of registration now being employed for gasoline rations.

A spokesman for the boards' gasoline panel invited attention to the fact that all holders of B and C books are requested to file their application for renewal of gas line 30 days prior to the expiration date of the book now being used.

Application blanks are available at any tire inspection station or at Rationing Board headquarters. Tire inspection records are to accompany all applications.

Lima's war industries are cooperating in the work of renewing gasoline rations thru their active transportation committees. Employees of war plants are filing their applications for gasoline and their tire inspection records with the transportation committee at the place of their employment.

All other applications are to be mailed, together with tire inspection records, to the War Price and Rationing Board, High and Elizabeth-sts.

Applicants not working in plants are not making their renewal applications as rapidly as they should, board officials said. They pointed out that unless they send in their applications at once, their rations may be delayed a few days.

VICTORY LOAN GOAL EXCEEDED IN PUTNAM - CO

(Lima News Bureau) OTTAWA, May 12.—Purchases of War Savings during the recent second Victory Loan drive in Putnam-co almost surpassed the county's \$1,580,000 goal by one million dollars.

The county war bond committee today released its official final figures but a few thousand dollars may be added to this total when the final totals on sales made direct to the treasury department have been added, it was explained.

The county figures show a total of \$2,546,577.50 in purchases for an over-subscription of the quota of \$966,577.

Of the total purchases, \$536,157.50 was from private citizens. There were credits of \$27,750 from the state's bond purchases, \$100,000 from the county purchase, \$16,650 from the State Teacher's Retirement System purchases and \$10,000 from Ohio Power Co. purchases for a total of \$154,500.

Banks purchased \$960,000, while other financial institutions purchased \$200,000 worth of bonds. The remainder of the total purchases came from credit of \$696,000 for purchases made in Putnam-co during the first three months of 1943.
