May 22 — Persons whose last name begins with K and L may call at Lima state liquor store until 9 p. m. for their ration books.

Others apply for liquor ration cards as follows: Persons whose last names begin with A to L, May 22; M and N, May 21; O, P, Q, and R, May 25; S, May 26; T, U, V, W, X, Y, and Z, May 27; all between A and Z unable to pick up cards previously, May 28 and 29.

May 21 — Last day to use gasoline coupon No. 5 in A books.

May 30—Last day for Stamp 23 for one pound of coffee.

May 31—Blue G, H and J stamps in War Ration Book Two for processed foods expire this date.

May 31—Fire inspection deadline for holders of T and C books.

May 31 — Last day for five pounds of sugar with Stamp No. 12. Stamp 13 good for 5 pounds June 1 thru Aug. 15. Two stamps will be designated for canning sugar, and applications for additional may be made to ration boards from May 24 to June 10.

June 15 — Last day for one pair of shoes with Stamp 17.

June 30—Fire inspection deadline for holders of B books.

Persons applying to the Ration Board for additional shoe stamp must present all the Number One Ration Books issued to the family.

NURSES' AID CLASS TO OPEN

Hospitals Plead For More Help As Date Is Set For Training Group

Longer hours as well as more volunteer workers was suggested Friday by Mrs. Walter Noble, chairman of the nurse aid program of the Allen-co Red Cross chapter as executives of Lima's two hospitals renewed their pleas for more help for their over-worked staffs.

One new daytime class will start June 14 at St. Rita's hospital, and afternoon and evening classes are scheduled in the near future at Memorial hospital.

Vacancies still exist in all future classes, and applications are being taken at the Red Cross workrooms in the Gas Co. building. Part of the 80 hours work in the training course consists of hospital service, and nurse aids agree to give 150 hours a year to the work after receiving their diplomas.

This represents only about three hours a week, Mrs. Noble pointed

out, so that a large number of nurse aids is needed to fill the need created by departure of nurses for wartime service and the increase in the number of patients because of the lack of facilities for care in the home.

The Red Cross is striving to meet the emergency by training new classes constantly, but Mrs. Noble suggested that a speedier solution is the enrollment of women who can afford to devote more than 150 hours a year to the work. Many of those now in ranks of nurse aids are housewives who are maintaining homes in addition to their hospital work. Enrollment of women whose home duties do not require so much of their time would ease the burden at the hospitals, she explained.
