

### JAPAN ADMITS DAMAGE TO 19 SHIPS IN MONTH

(By The Associated Press)  
Japan today officially acknowledged damage to 19 vessels in the Southwest Pacific since April. An Imperial headquarters announcement broadcast by Tokyo and recorded by The Associated Press, said merely that "our damages since April comprise 19 vessels," but the communique gave a strong indication that some, and possibly all, were sunk.

At the same time, Imperial headquarters claimed Japanese forces sank 13 Allied vessels in the South Pacific between May 5 and May 24, five of them transports. The claim was unsubstantiated by Allied reports on shipping losses.
