BRICKER SIGNS LAST BILLS FROM ASSEMBLY

COLUMBUS, July 1 -- (UP)-Governor Bricker today signed a bill creating a 21-member postwar program planning commission and measures enacted during closing days of the legislative session increasing pay of county engineers, establishing a state commission to consider problems of small business, creating a rehabilitation fund for weak school districts, and increasing wages of county jail matrons.

Of the 225 bills enacted by the legislature, only one, the biennial sundry claims measure, still remains on the governor's desk for final action. He has vetoed eight and signed 215 bills.

It was the opinion of advisory committee members that "the only reason for the recent decline in hog pieces has been the inability of packers to slaughter negs, due to the labor shortage and inadequacy of refrigerating


