SOLDIERS CHEAT DEATH DESPITE HEART BULLETS

CAMBRIDGE, O., July 23 -(INS) - Cheating death on the battlefields of North Africa, Sgt. Arthur Miller, 22, Ft. Payne, Ala., and Sgt. Albert Micheal, 26, Ashland, Ö., are living examples that a man may be shot in the heart -and even bear a bullet in that vital organ — and survive. Sgts. Miller and Micheal are

patients at Fletcher General hospital and are making satisfactory recovery from other wounds, althoeach has a bullet lodged in the center muscles of his heart. No effort will be made to remove Major O. E. Nadeau, chief of

surgical service at Fletcher hospital, says the hearts of these two young men are functioning normally and "in all probability they will live to a ripe old age.

In each instance the bullet is lodged in the muscles between the main cavities of the heart, close to the valve thru which the blood passes in and out of the organ, but apparently has caused "How the bullets got into the heart muscles and why they did not drop out, we do not know, Major Nadeau said.

Miller and Micheal are eager to recover and get back into action to avenge their wounds, but in all likelihood they will have to leave this to their buddies.


