TREMBLING poplar! That is one of the names of the aspen tree, which belongs to the poplar family. The tree does tremble in a sense of the

breeze will set it a-flutter, indeed a breeze so small that a person might not notice it.

The aspen is not one of the most common trees, but it is found in many places. It grows from the northern part of Siberia to the British Isles in England, and across Canada to Alaska. In the United States it is a native of both Maine and California, and that statement can be made about only a very few native trees. One of the others is the black willow.

The leaves of the aspen provide the rustling sound. They rub against one another when they are touched by a gentle breeze.

There is a legend that the cross on which Jesus was crucified was made from aspen wood. The legend says that the tree trembles for that reason!

hold herring. Some wooden trays and bowls are made from it today.

During the Middle Ages in Europe, aspen wood was valued for the making of arrows. While King Henry V was on the English throne, a law was passed that no man should use such wood for any other purpose. For anyone who did so, there was a fine equal to about \$25 in our money.

Aspens often reach a height of from 60 to 80 feet. Now and then they grow as high as 100 feet. Their trunks may be as much as three feet thick.

These trees grow at points near sea level, also on the sides of mountains. In the United States and Mexico, dwarf aspens are found on mountains more than a mile and a half above sea level.
