"Case Of The Stuttering Records" To Be Aired On Mystery Spot; Blondie Features "Going Into A Trance"

The stirring story of the men who fly the fog-filled skies of the Aleutians will be told on "Cavalcade of America" Monday. (WEAF, 8 p. m., EWT), when Screen Star Ralph Bellamy stars in a special dramatization of Corey Ford's bestseller, "Short Cut to Tokyo."

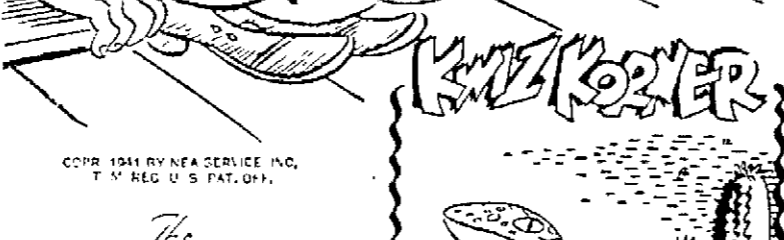

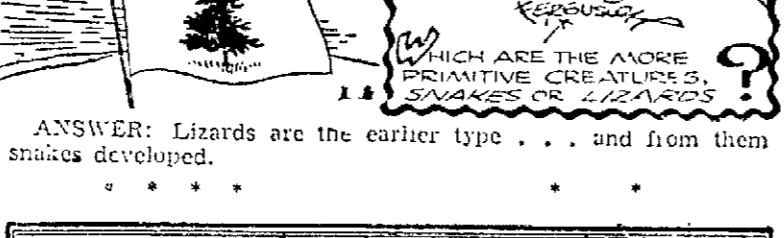

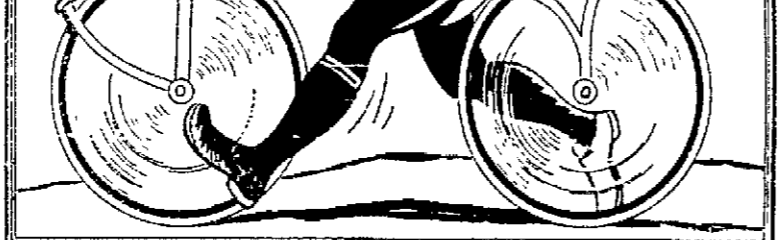

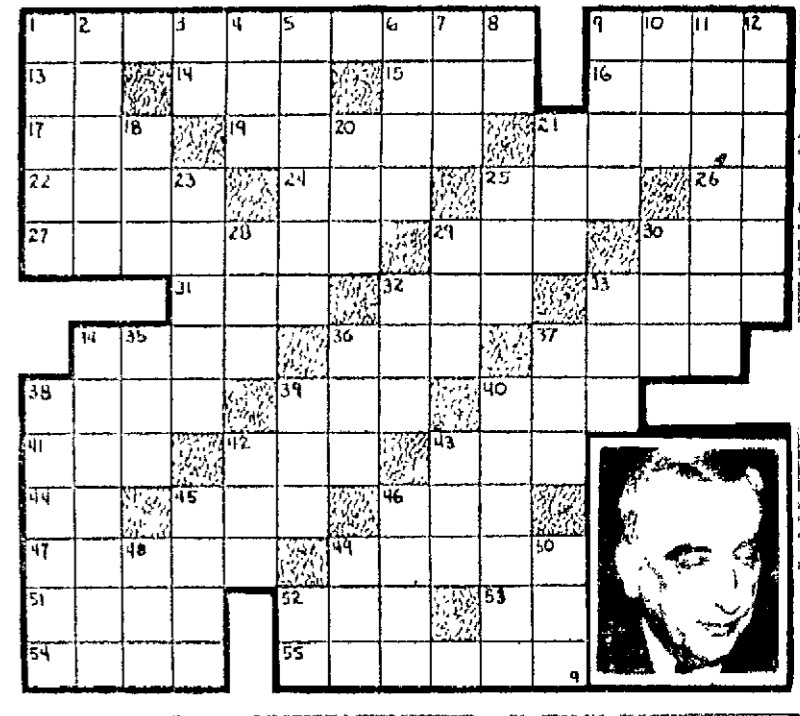

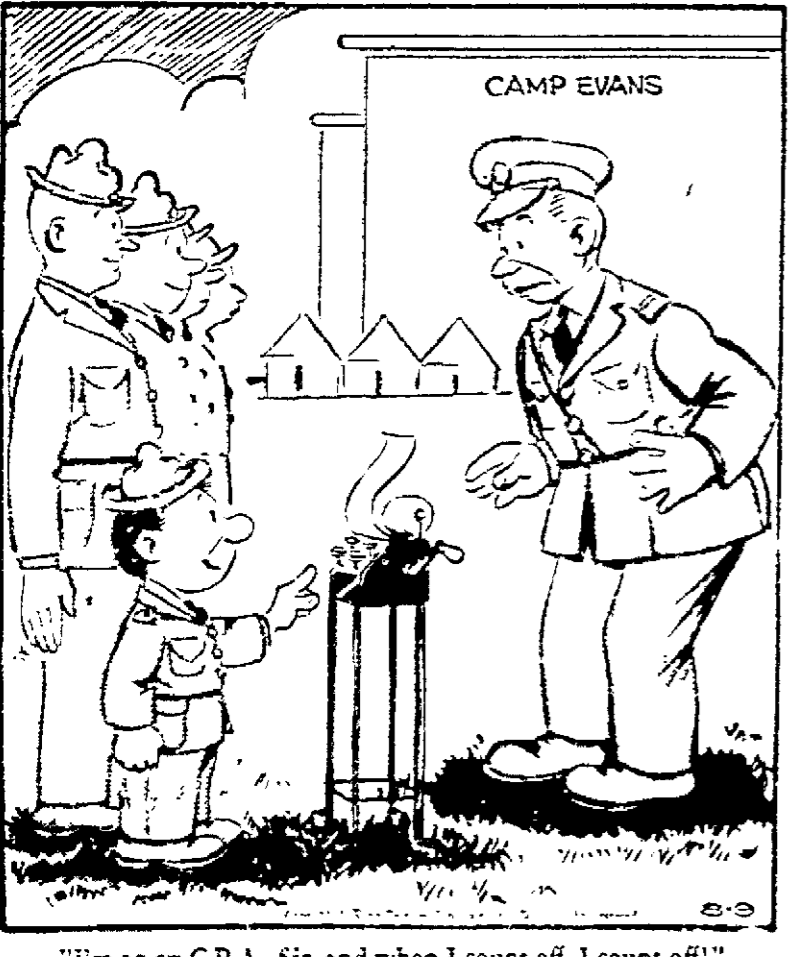

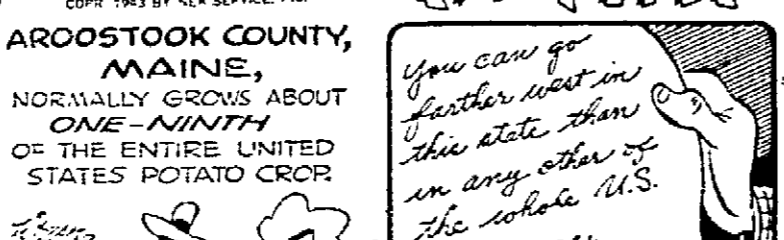
