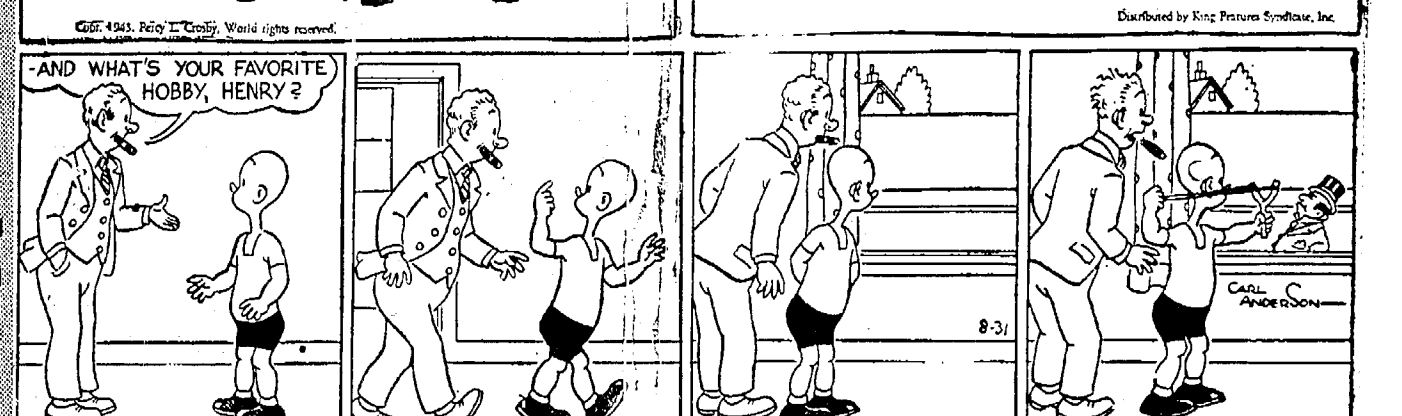
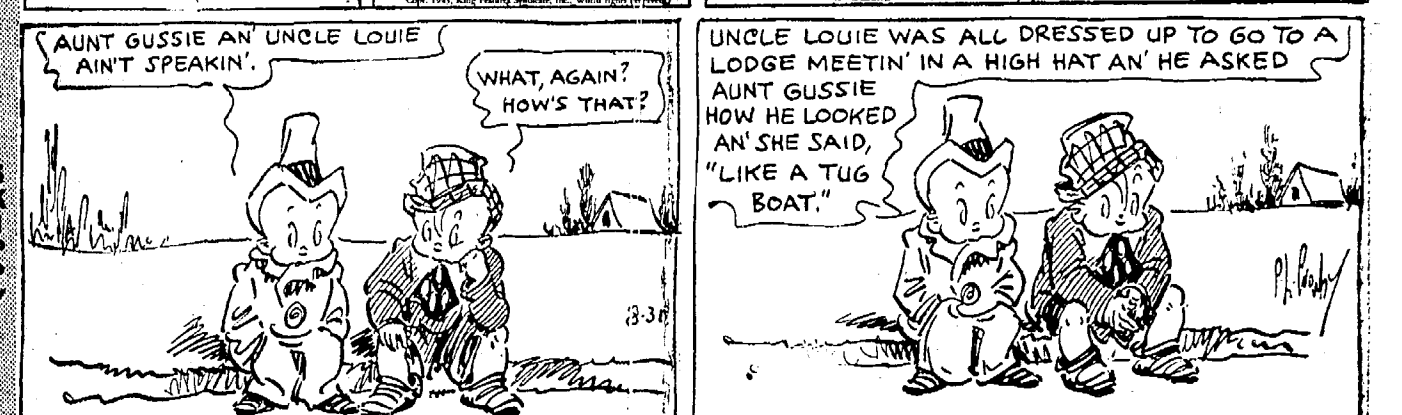
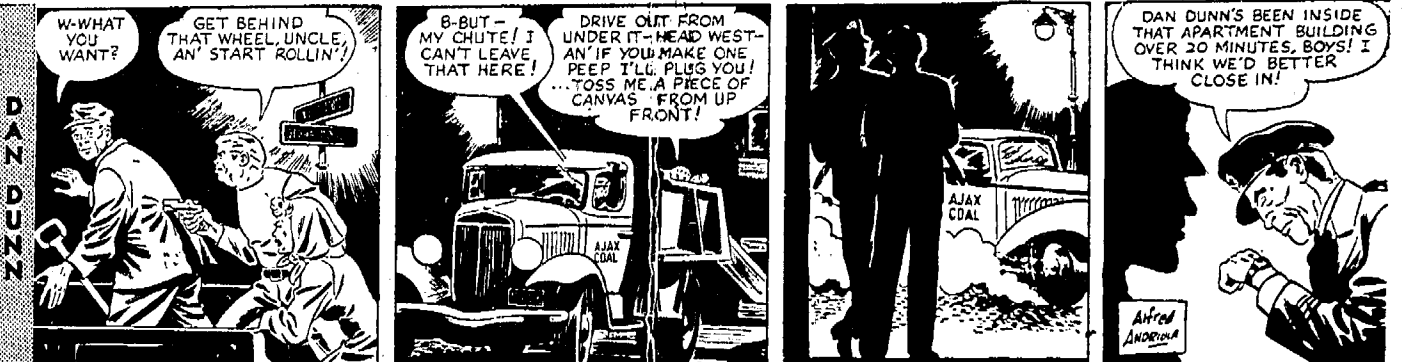
DAILY CROSSWORD
