Bette Davis, prize winning actress, is co-starred with Paul Lukas in "Watch on the Rhine," which commences an engagement at the Ohio on Friday. This suspense packed production has in the supporting roles Geraldine Fitzgerald, Beulah Bondi and Lucile Watson. Ending Thursday will be Irving Berlin's "This Is the Army."

The Office of Price Administration (OPA) announced it would boost to four points the ration price of an 8-ounce package of tomato sauce in combination with cheese, but said they could all be blue. Before the change the same package cost one red point for the cheese and two blue points for the tomato sauce.
