## Uncle Ray's Corner

**CAPTAIN DIED AFTER BEING STRUCK BY SWORDFISH**

AN UNHAPPY event took place off the Massachusetts coast on an August day in 1886.

Capt. F. D. Langford and three of his men boarded a dory and went after a swordfish which had been harpooned. Picking up the eak inside the dory, the captain pulled on the line, which was very tight because the fish was trying to get away. When most of the line was in, the fish suddenly turned and swam toward the boat.

With the slackening of the line, the captain fell backward. While he was lying on the bottom of the dory, the swordfish struck and his sword came through the wood, striking Langford in the back.

The schooner soon came alongside. Not knowing how badly he had been hurt, the captain climbed out of the dory and aboard the schooner. There he took only a few steps before he fell on the deck. Three days later he died.

Time and again swordfish have attacked dories, sending their swords through the bottom. The part of the sword which comes into sight inside the boat may be from 12 to 25 inches long. Usually it breaks off while the fish struggles to get free.

Swordfish swim at a speed of perhaps a mile a minute when they drive into a boat. They more often attack small boats than large ones, but they have been known to strike big vessels as well.

Up to the time the Japanese captured Singapore, that city had a museum with a piece of oak plank three inches thick. The wood was taken from the side of a goodsized vessel which had been struck by a swordfish. A section of the sword, imbedded in the oak, was on display. Very possibly the museum and the exhibit still exist in Singapore, but in these times of war we can hardly be sure about such things.

The swordfish has the largest eyes among all the fish which swim the sea. Sometimes its eyes measure three and a half inches across!

The swordfish has a large weapon, but an even larger one belongs to the sawfish. We shall speak about sawfish in our next story.
