




Sawfish like warm water, but they seem to care little for deep water. Seldom are they found in the deeper parts of the ocean. They go into bays and the mouths of rivers. Sometimes they enter the Mississippi and go upstream for several miles.

Tales have been told of sawfish attacking whales and slicing off "steaks." The truth seems to be that they cut into whales at times. but they do not depend on whales for their food supply. Whales spend their time chiefly in deep water, not in the shallow water favored by sawfish.

The food supply of sawfish is made up largely of sardines, mullets, anchovies and other small fish. The mouths of these fish are feet. Some, however, are 20 feet small, and are on the underside of the head.


