Double Bill Opens Thursday; Marine Picture Starring Wallace Beery Held Over At The Sigma

The strange three-cornered struggle between an ace Nazi pilot, British Intelligence officers and a Gestapo agent offers thrilling and dramatic action in "Squadron Leader X," which commences an engagement at the State on Thursday. Eric Portman, and Ann Dvorak are starred. "Two Tickets to London," also will open. "China" and "Yanks Ahoy!" show thru Wednesday.

Because of popular demand, "Salute to the Marines," line war picture, will be held over at the Sigma thru Friday. Wallace Beery is at his best portraying a fighting marine and he is supported by Fay Bainter, Reginald Owen and Ray Collins. Also held over is "Henry Aldrich Swings It."

Opening Wednesday at the Drive in will be "Hangmen Also Die" starring Brian Donlevy and Walter Brennan. Ending Tuesday will be "Reveille With Beverly." Robert Donat, who charmed you as "Mr. China" will thrill you in the role of "The Young Mr. Pitt," romantic drama of a generation like ours, currently at the Lyric. Broadway's gripping mystery, "Murder in Time Square," completes the program.

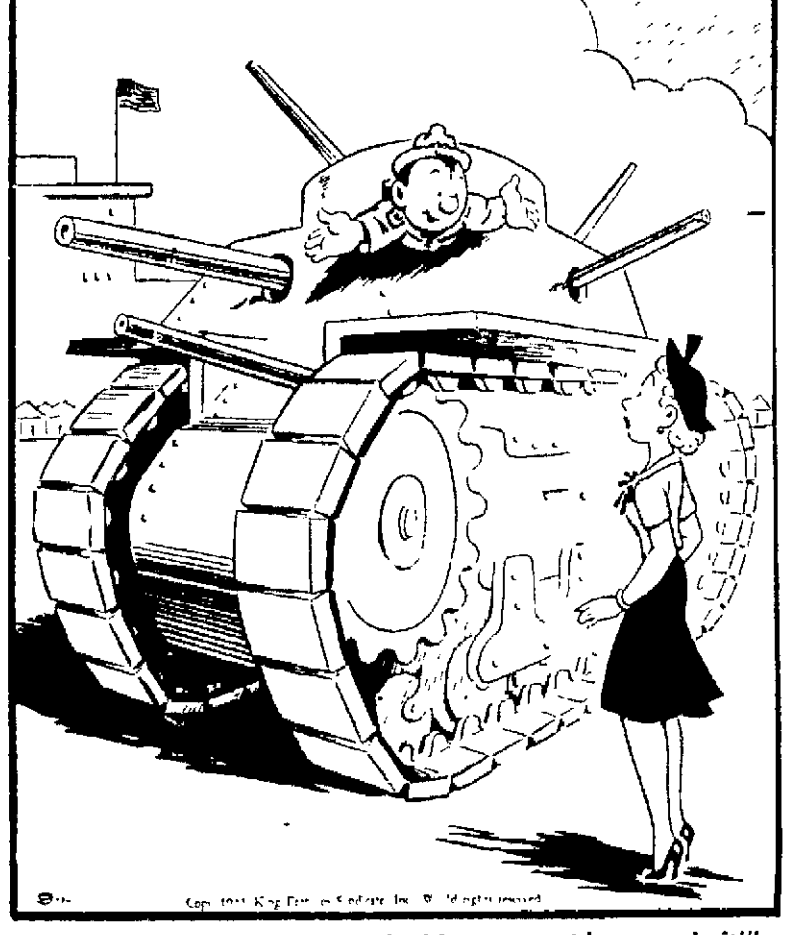
