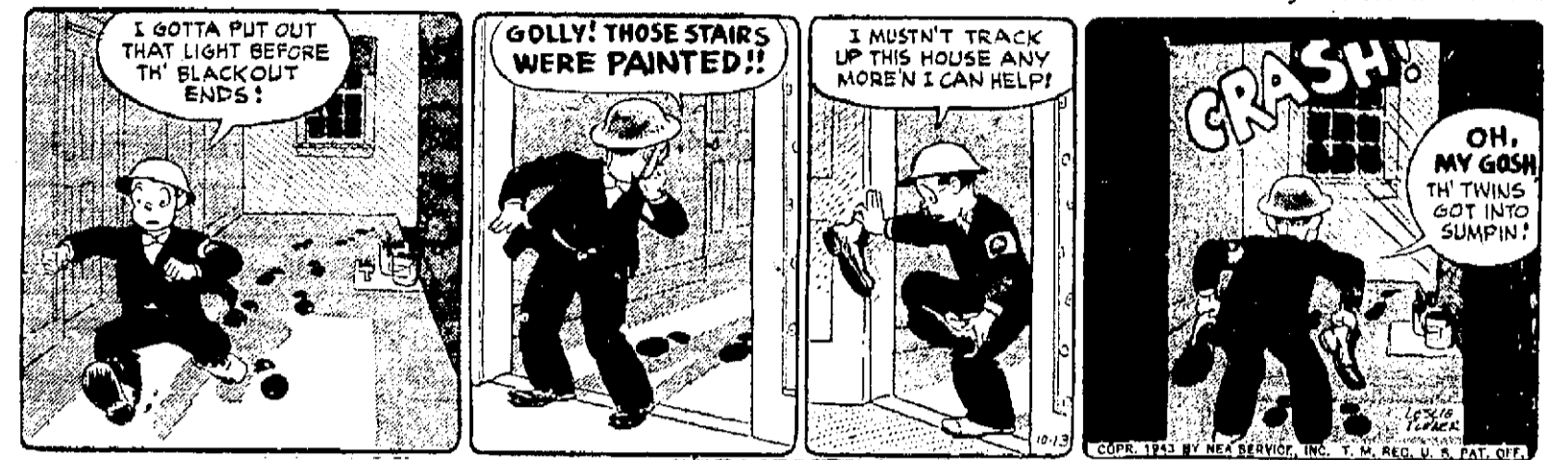

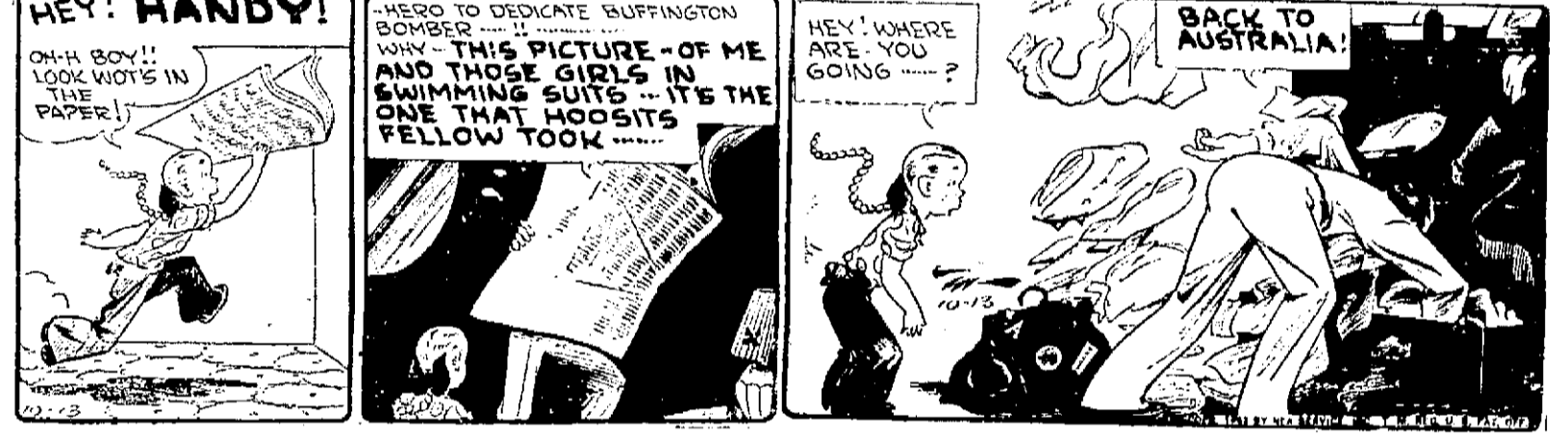

BOMBS DAMAGE BURMA BRIDGE

NEW DELHI, Oct. 12 (AP)—Headquarters of the 10th U. S. Air Force announced today that the important Meza river bridge on the main line of the Mandalay-Mythikya railroad in Japanese-occupied Burma had been seriously damaged during a raid by heavy American bombers Oct. 10. A communique said the bridge, southwest of Naba Junction in Central Burma, consisted of "three large spans crossing the river and five approach spans on the north-eastern bank." One end of the eastern main span was dropped into the river by the American attack and three of the approach spans were demolished. The first seed-bearing plants appeared about 100,000,000 years ago.
