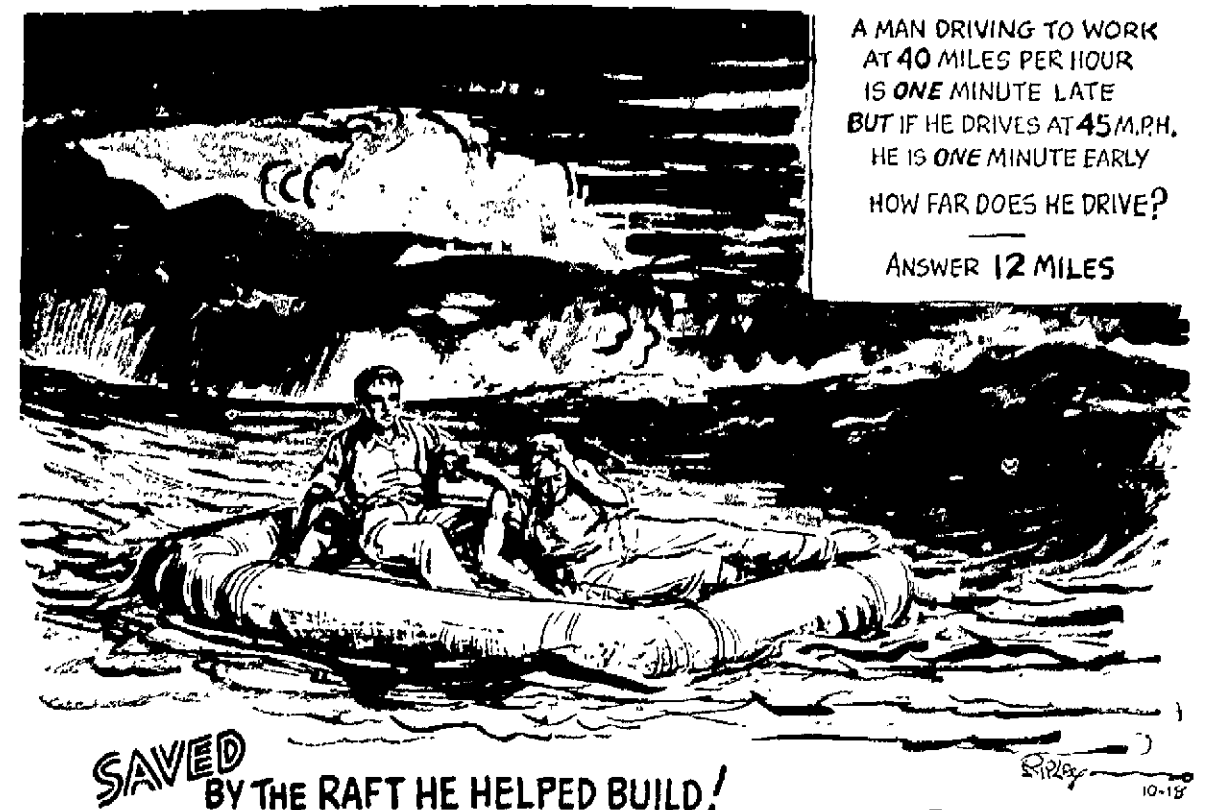

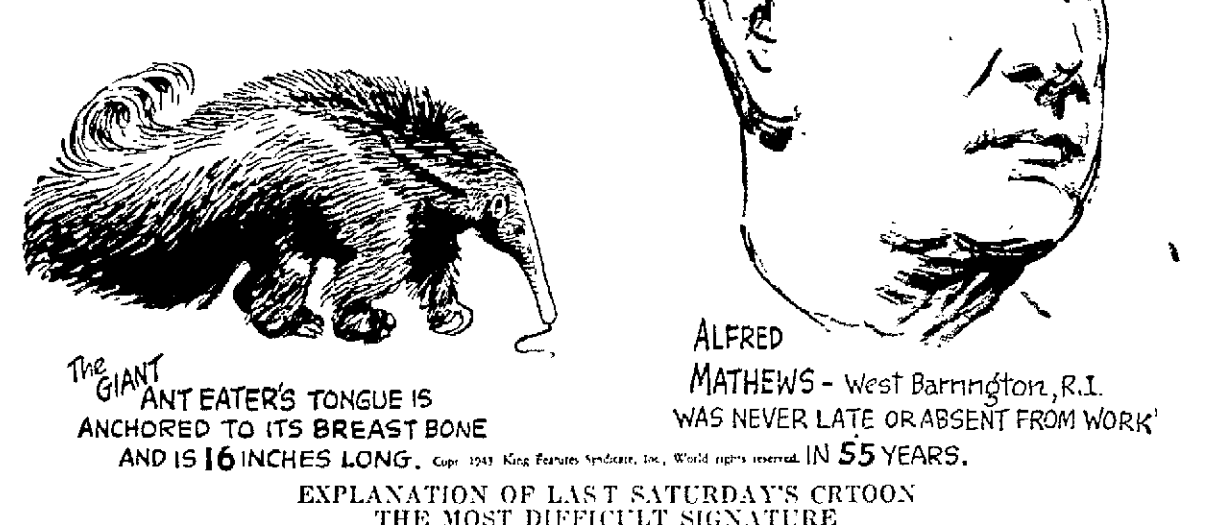

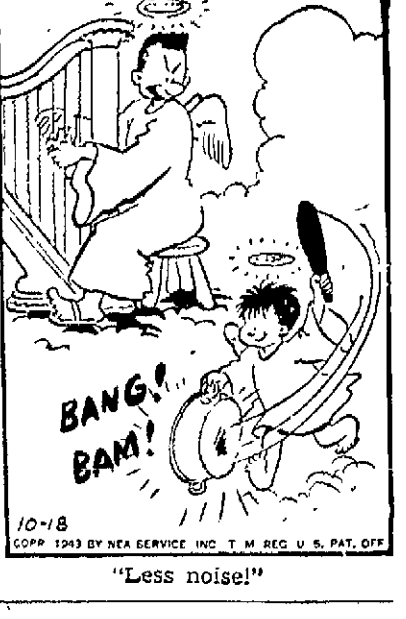

CZECH REFUGEE REPORTS NAZI FEAR OF DEFEAT

LONDON, Oct. 18—(AP) — A Czech who recently escaped from Germany said today that fear of losing the war is predominant in the minds of most Germans, while others believe some sort of colossal stroke is being prepared against Great Britain in retaliation for air raids against the Reich.

This report was made thru the Czechoslovak press bureau by a Czech intellectual who fled a Nazi prison where he had been interned for more than three years. His name was not revealed.

Also the German people do not dare express their opinions openly, the Czech said the general mood of pessimism in the country is revealed in such mumbled phrases as "terrible sacrifices" and "gloomy future."
