Yanks Capture Nazis for Help

ALLIED HEADQUARTERS, Algiers (AP)—A group of American stretcher-bearers attached to the Fifth Army told how they captured seven German prisoners and immediately put them to work evacuating wounded over rocky mountain trails.

"Our men were finding the 7-mile trip to the nearest station a tedious slow job," said Sgt. Lloyd Brink, Melvin, Ia., "so when we stumbled on a German unit we took them prisoners and put them to work carrying stretchers."

Brink and others of a medical unit including Pvt. George Diebel, Brooklyn; Pvt. Clarence Ghent, Big Creek, W. Va.; Pvt. Edward Fasano, New Haven, Conn. and Pvt. Donald H. Keller, Marlinton, W. Va., were working immediately behind the fighting line in Italy.

Rounding a hill they found the seven Germans sitting around a small camp. Brink challenged the surprised Nazi troopers who threw up their hands in surrender.

Rather than have the prisoners walk back to the next base empty-handed, the first aid men decided to let them aid with the evacuation of wounded.

LANDSLIDES DANGERS HOVER OVER MOUNTAIN DWELLERS

PEOPLE who live on the sides of mountains may have pretty scenery, but a special kind of danger hovers over them. There is no telling when a "landslide" or "avalanche" will cause them harm.

In India, on a slope of the Himalayas, is the little city of Naina Tal with a population of 10,000. For many years it has been a health resort. Sixty-three years ago, after heavy rains, a

section of the town slid into the lake beside which it was built. Many houses were buried in a mass of water, soil and rock. Forty white persons lost their lives, and about 150 natives.

In 1772 a mass of peat in Scotland, at Solway Moss, was soaked with heavy rain. Then it gave way and spread down to nearby fields. The black mud formed by this peat covered an area of 400 acres. It is possible for a landslide to cut right through a village and destroy a section of it. That happened in Somo, Switzerland, in 1924. Dozens of houses were knocked to pieces as a mass of

rocks and soil tumbled down the mountain and passed through the village.

England had a chalk-and-sand landslide in 1839 in Dorsetshire, near Axminster. A large amount of chalk and green sand poured down a slope and into the sea. Sand of green color exists in some hills of England and other countries.

Probably the worst landslides in history took place in China in 1920. The slides were set loose by a violent earthquake in Kansu province, and millions of tons of the dark soil called "loess" fell from hills and mountains. It was estimated that more than 100,000 persons died as a result. "The mountains walked in the night," reported a man who lived in the region but was not hurt.
