





Hawks Sometimes Steal Fowls Under Farmer's Eyes

N THE whole hawk family, no members are more bold or hard-hitting than the goshawks.

The name "goshawk" is a short form of "goose-hawk," and these birds have been used to "fly at geese" in the old sport of falconry, in which a trained bird chases and captures game for its master. In the Middle Ages, the goshawk was looked upon as a good bird for the purpose, but most of the nobles used falcons.

Goshawks are fairly wide-spread over the world. Some are found in Asia and northern Europe. Canada has many of them, and so does the United States.


