






MINSTER MAN LISTED MISSING

Sgt. Luke Barga, 22, Reported Lost On Mission

(Special To The Lima News)

MINSTER, Dec. 3—Mr. and Mrs. L. O. Barga, farm couple living southwest of Minster, have been notified by the War department that their son, S. Sgt. Luke Barga, 22, aerial engineer and gunner aboard a Flying Fortress, has been missing in action since a bombing raid in Italy, Nov. 10.

Sgt. Barga had been stationed in North Africa since Oct. 13, but the raid Nov. 10 was reported to have been his first combat mission. He was inducted into the armed forces Sept. 26, 1942, and was immediately assigned to air corps service. He completed his training at Chanute Field, Rantoul, Ill., after having been stationed at Atlantic City, N. J., at Lincoln Air base, Lincoln, Neb., Ephrata Air base, Ephrata, Wash., and Rapid City, S. D.

A brother, Francis, also a staff sergeant, is stationed in the Aleutians. He entered military service in February, 1942.
