

"Crime Doctor" Has Most Important Case At Quilna

Starring Warner Baxter as Dr. Ordway, "Crime Doctor," which takes its title and characters from the famous radio program is now showing at the Quilna theatre.

"Never Been Licked" and "Murder at the Waterfront" open at the State Thursday with "Dubarry Was a Lady" and "Seventh Victim" closing Wednesday night.
