Judy Canova, imitable songstress of the backwoods, will be seen thru Wednesday on the Lyric screen in "Sleepy Lagoon."

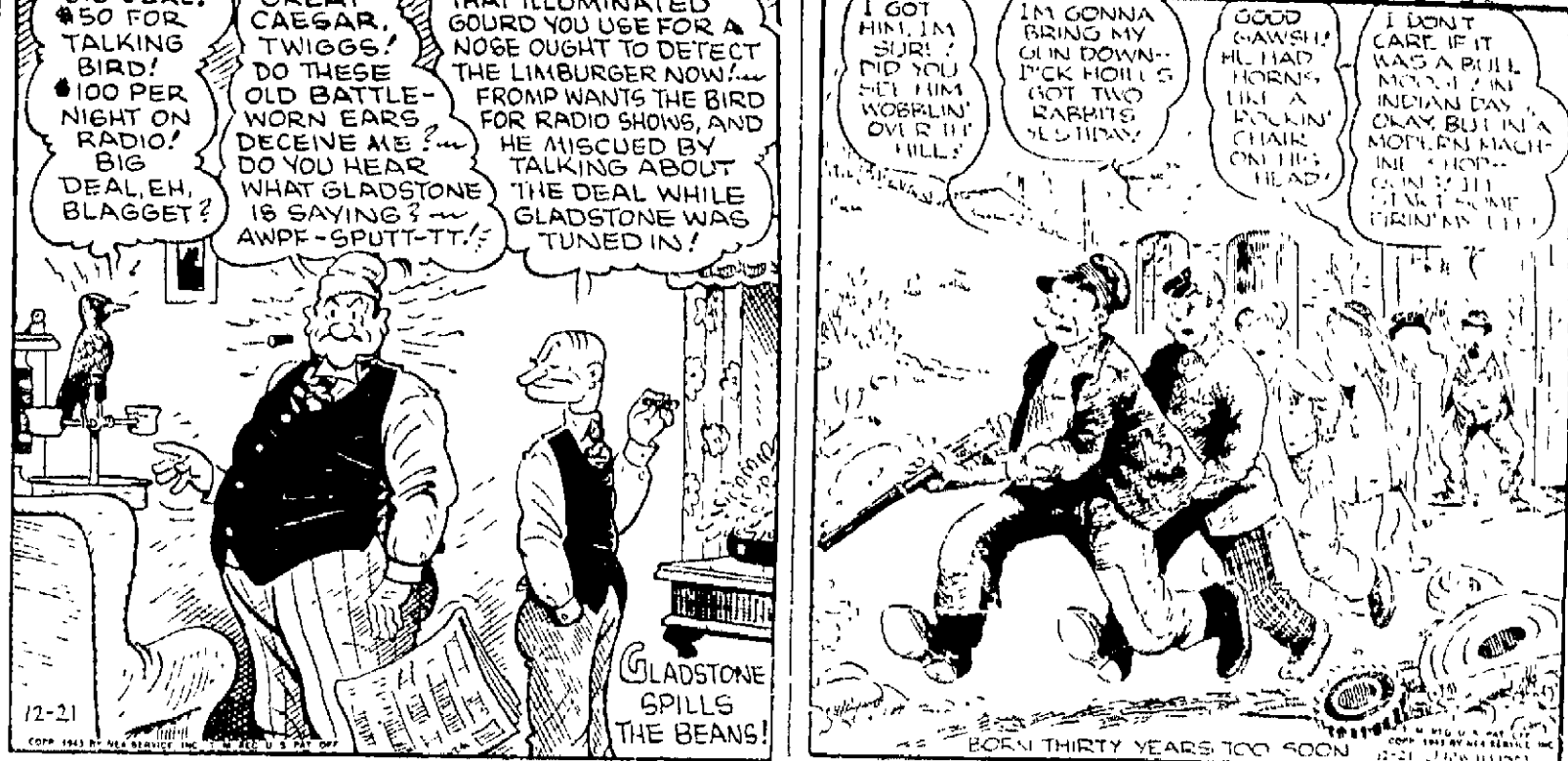

Joseph Santley directed the film under Associate Producer Albert J. Cohen.

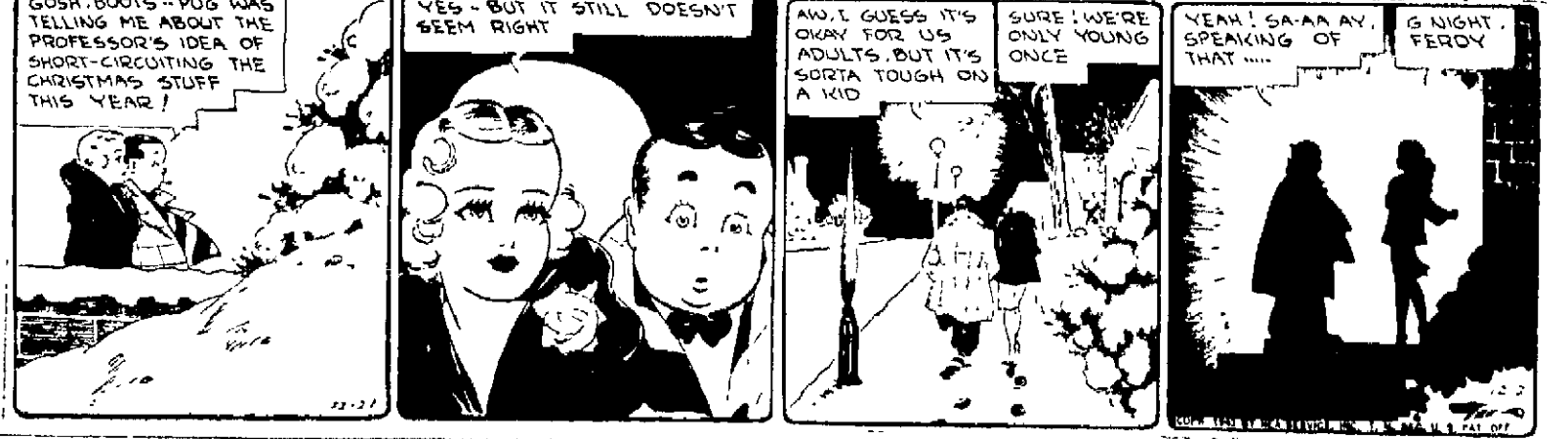
