PRECIPITATION **DURING WINTER** HALF NORMAL

COLUMBUS, O., Jan. 19-(AP) -()hio has been experiencing one of the driest winters in years, but crops will escape damage if rainfall is normal between now and early spring, Ohio State university experts asserted today.

Precipitation during the past four months was 5.88 inches, little more than half the 10.69 normal, while December's 1.06 inches was the lowest since 1925 when a record low of .82 was set, the school's agricultural extension service reported. Th eservice said, however, the

situation was not critical and "even normal rainfall" between now and spring would prevent crop damage. The 5.38 inches of precipitation compares with approximately seven inches which should be stored in the soil before spring planting begins, the service declared.
