COLUMBUS, O., Feb. 15—(AP)—Ohio State university has asked the Navy department to release Lt. Harlan H. Hatcher from duty so he can become dean of the college of arts and sciences, University President Howard L. Bevis announced today.

Hatcher, a member of the university since 1922 and recently professor of English, is nationally known as a lecturer and author. He would replace Dr. Bland L. Stradley, promoted to vice president of Ohio State.

Dr. Bevis said Hatcher's naval assignment was teaching and editing at the Chapel Hill, N. C., pre-flight school.

Hatcher was born at Ironton, O., 45 years ago. He is married.

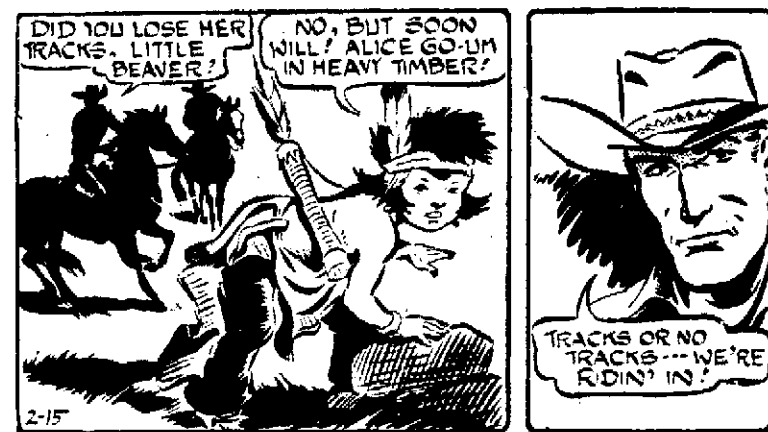

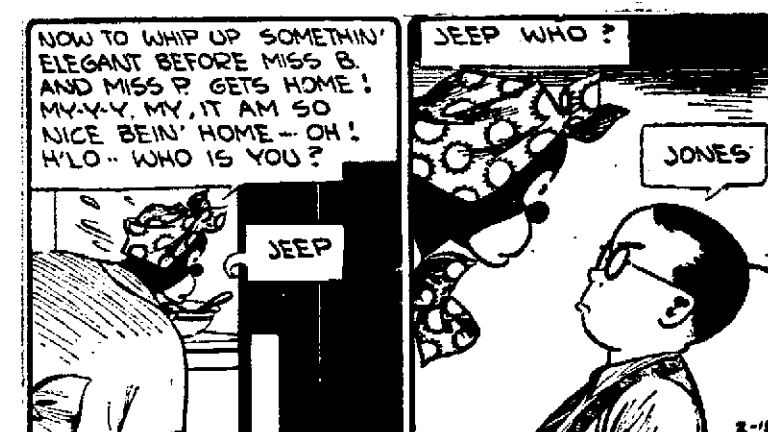

## CHAPLIN SHOWS NERVOUSNESS AS HE FACES COURT

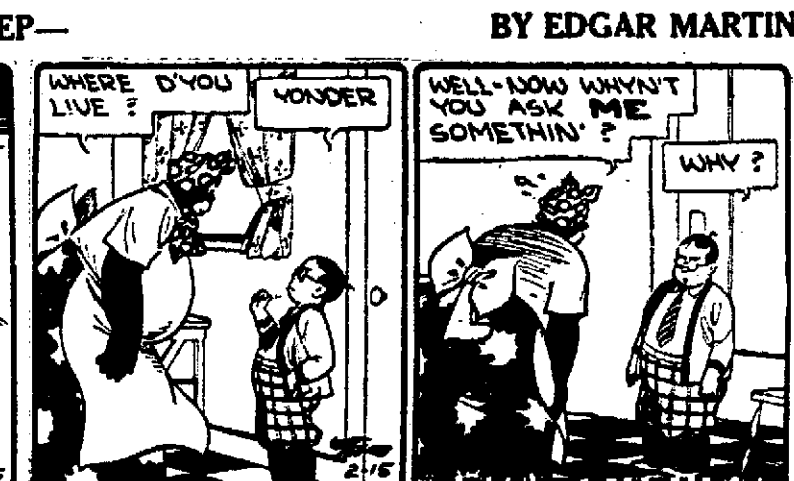
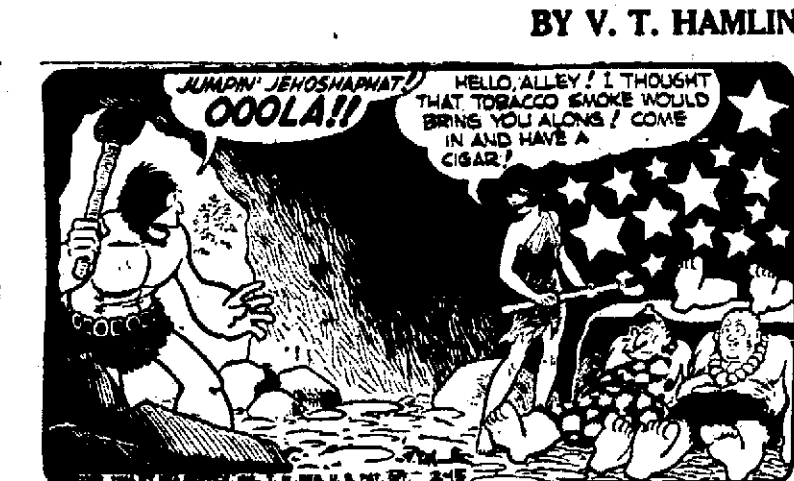
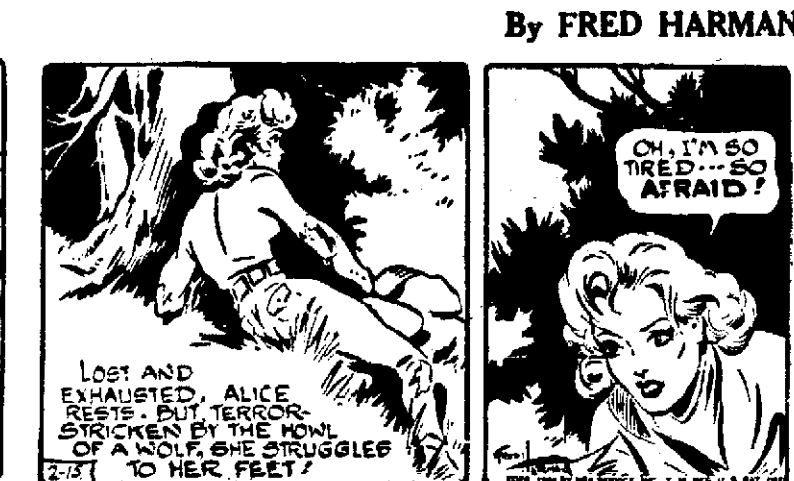
LOS ANGELES, Feb. 15—(INS)—The first act was over and the curtain lowered today on a real life drama more important to comedian Charles Chaplin than any he ever had portrayed on the screen.

Chaplin, along with four of six co-defendants, surrendered yesterday to the U. S. marshal on "white slave" and conspiracy indictments involving 24-year-old Joan Barry, who accuses Chaplin of being the father of her infant daughter.

Chaplin and the three others were freed without bail pending their arraignment. U. S. District Attorney Charles H. Carr said he expected the other two under conspiracy indictment to surrender shortly. They are Judge Charles H. Griffin of Beverly Hills and Jessie Billie Reno, Beverly Hills police matron.

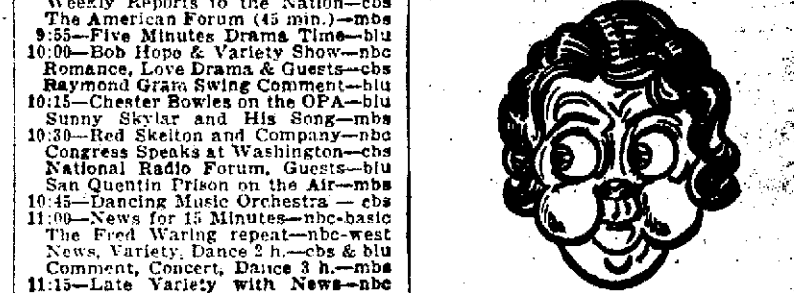
Half the audience of 9,000 will be made up of Navy personnel, with the remaining seats going to civilian bond buyers.

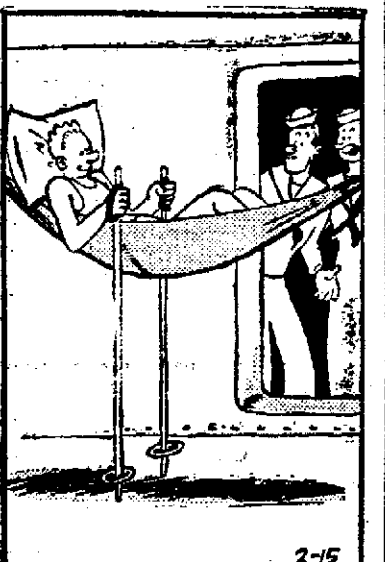
