## MENTAL HEALTH CLINICS URGED FOR WAR VETS

COLUMBUS, O., Feb. 16—(AP)—Ohio was urged today to establish clinics to help returning war veterans orient themselves to community life.  
States and communities will have to assume leadership in caring for such cases, Dr. Luther E. Woodward of New York asserted at the first general meeting yesterday of the governor's committee to study mental health and welfare problems.  
"While the more serious mental cases are being hospitalized, a great number of veterans suffering from acute anxieties induced by past experiences are returning to home communities in need of guidance for which there are no federal facilities," he explained.  
He suggested that veterans' clinics cooperate with employment services to provide both vocational and psychiatric guidance, when needed, for returning service personnel and civilians afflicted with "war jitters."
