

exchange must use long Form 1940. If farm produce is exchanged for merchandise, groceries, or the like, the market value of the articles received in exchange is to be included in gross income. In this instance, if a farmer traded cabbages for \$10 worth of harness, he should include the \$10 in his farm income, and the cost of raising the cabbages will be included in the farm expenses used in determining net income from the farm business. Where property is exchanged for property of another kind, or for ; services, the transaction may give rise to a capital gain or loss(if the property exchanged is a capital asset.) reportable in Sched-
