SEVERE LABOR SHORTAGE SEEN FOR CANNERIES

CLEVELAND, March 20-(INS) -Some communities in the Ohio-Michigan-Kentucky region may be forced practically to suspend normal business during the height of the canning season to provide the necessary manpower for canneries, War Manpower Commission officials warned today. The WMC said that such drastic

steps would have to be taken only in towns where very severe labor shortages develop as the canneries reach their peak production period. Earl Smith, WMC rural indus-

tries chief for Ohio, said that 35 to 36,000 cannery workers would be needed in the three-state region if a normal crop is harvested. Twenty-one thousand, one-third of them men, will be required in A tentative plan calls for the


