NYE ANNOUNCES 10 POINTS FOR GOVERNOR RACE

COLUMBUS, March 21—(UP)—Frank A. Nye, Columbus attorney, today announced a 10-point platform on which he said he will make his bid for the Democratic nomination for governor in the May primary.

Nye also called for election of a congress "desirous of preventing future wars, and anxious to do something about it."

Nye also announced his platform "believing that the citizens of Ohio have a right to know, and should know what I stand for and what my ideas of government are."

Its planks included:

Reduction of governmental costs without sacrificing efficiency, retention of the state liquor monopoly to private business, construction and maintenance of a high grade state highway system, simplification of government and the relief of local government of financial and other obligations to the state.

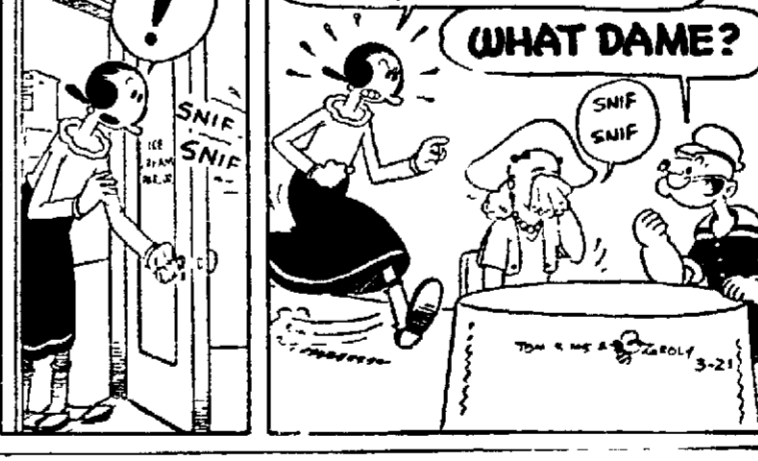
