OTTAWA, April 11 — An officers' training meeting will be held May 11 here by the Putnamco 4-H club council.

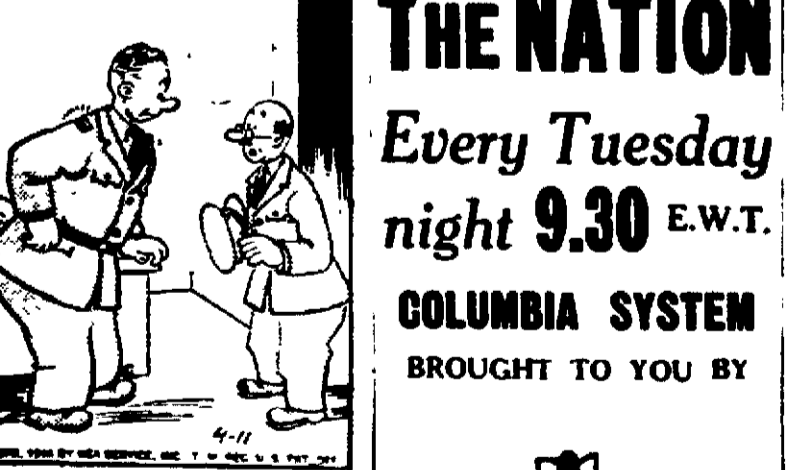

GENTILE SQUAD CREDITED WITH 405 NAZI SHIPS

LONDON, April 11—(INS) — Col. Donald J. N. Blakeslee's fighting group whose pilots include top-ranking ace Capt. Don Gentile of Piqua, Ohio, was credited today with the record-breaking destruction of 405 enemy planes.

A recheck of headquarters figures, which yesterday had listed 403 Nazi planes on the group's list, showed that two others also have been destroyed by Blakeslee's men. Of the 405 planes destroyed, 105 were bagged on the ground and 300 in the air.

During the last 10 days, the group has accounted for 100 Nazi craft, official sources revealed.

The announcement was made while Gentile waited to receive official recognition later today of his record-breaking destruction of 30 German aircraft from one of the most eminent figures in the European theatre of operations—whose name has not yet been divulged.

More than 511 million calls were handled by Washington telephone operators last year.
