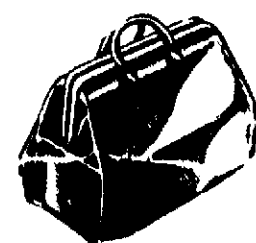
The campaign will be launched immediately it was stated and
