
14 MORE ARE INDICTED FOR CONSPIRACY

LANSING Mich , May 2-(AP) -A grand jury investigating allegations of graft in Michigan's legislature today charged 14 persons with conspiracy to corrupt the 1939 session-an action tollowing a previous similar indictment of 26 individuals. The indictment was returned

by the one-man grand jury of Circuit Judge Leland W. Carr and alleged the giving and acceptance of bribes for the votes of legislators. The original indictment made identical charges. Special Prosecutor Kim Sigler said a blanket warrant today named five men as bribers and nine present and past members of the legislature as bribe takers to the extent of "several thouannd dollars " He said the bribes involved legislation for taxation of intangible personal property such as stocks and
