1,200 JOIN WALKOUT AT TIMKEN PLANT

CANTON, O., May 9—(AP)—The Timken Roller Bearing Co.'s Canton plant steel mill was shut down today by a walkout of 1,200 workers.

A CIO United Steelworkers official reported labor leaders were "anxious to get this thing settled because the men are getting their temperatures up, and we're afraid the stoppage might spread to the Canton mill and bearing factory."

The official said the stoppage was in protest over promotion of helpers to inspectors. The walkout started last Wednesday when a handful of inspectors and inspectors' helpers left their jobs.

AMERICAN AIR FORCES REGROUPED IN CHINA

LONDON, May 9—(INS)—The American air forces in China are being reinforced and regrouped in preparation for powerful air attacks against the Japanese mainland, Axis quarters reported today.

The air forces in China commanded by Maj. Gen. Claire L. Chennault, after receiving reinforcements from India, have moved their base from Kunning, Yunnan province, to Kweilin, approximately 435 miles to the east in Kwangsi province, the German Agency DNB said, quoting a "front report" to the newspaper Asahi of Tokyo.
