more secretly by train yesterday from the Glendale, Cal cemetery where it was buried shortly after Rogers was killed Aug. 15, 1935. Only a small gathering of friends and relatives, fewer than a hundred, were permitted to attend the services. Among them were former Gov Leon C. Phillips of Okla. homa and the present governor, Robert S. Kerr.

Rogers' widow was prevented from coming from her home in Glendale by illness.
