ST. MARYS, June 2—Mackebach Bros. Lumber yard has changed hands, Russell E. Armstrong of the Modern Paint and Lumber Co., St. Marys, acquiring ownership of the 90-year-old local business. Armstrong bought the yards along with the stock and equipment from W. A. and August Mackebach, brothers who have operated the business since the death of their father the late William Mackebach.

## BOND REDEMPTION HITS PEAK IN MAY

WASHINGTON, June 2—(UP)—More war bonds were redeemed in May than in any month since they were first offered for sale, the treasury statement showed.

For the month thru May 30, \$713,897,992 of series E bonds were sold and \$211,714,318 were cashed in or 38 per cent of sales for the period. May 31 redemptions, when reported, probably will make the month total about \$280,000,000.

Previous monthly record for redemptions was in March when tax payments caused many people to turn in their bonds and \$268,000,000 were redeemed.

Of slightly over \$32,000,000, 000 of all bonds of series E, F and G May 1, 1941, thru May 30, 1944, however, only about nine per cent or \$2,800,000,000 have been cashed in.
