Completing the program is "Pride of the Plains" with the government film, "Memphis Belle," also showing. The meeting is open to all Lima women.

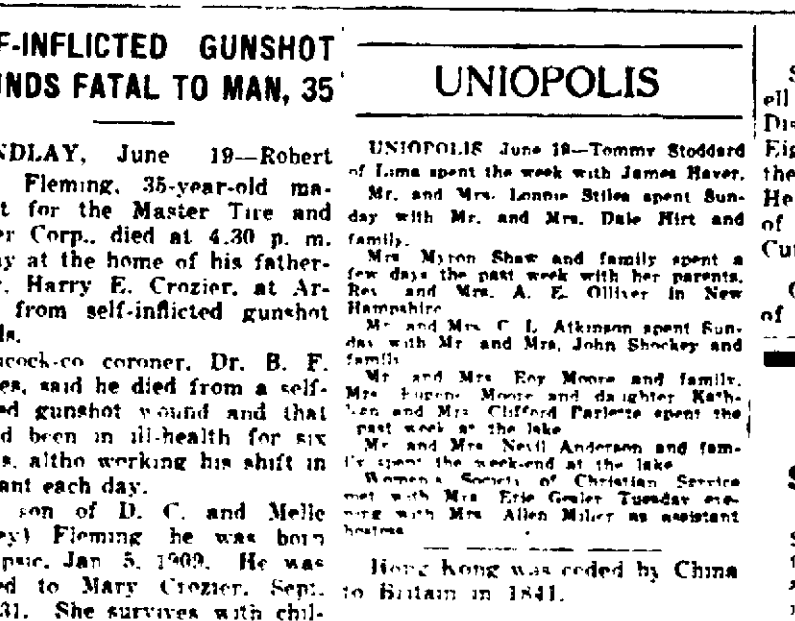
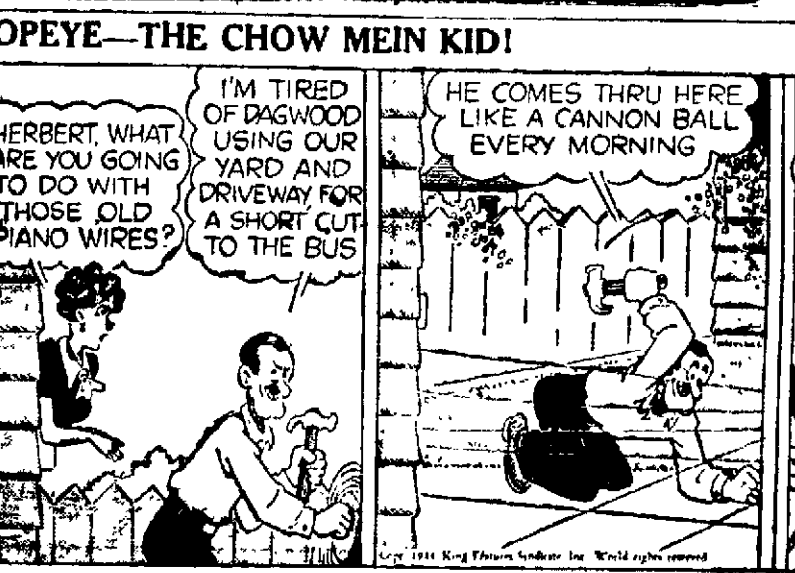
