

estimates have been above 1,000 fine white porcelain, but they were not content with that. They wanted to color the material, and to put pictures and designs on it. While the Ming emperors were

on the the throne, Chinese potters made blue and white porcelain which was to become famous. Much porcelain of that kind later was experted from Nanking, and was given the name of "Old Nanking." Although it bore the name of that city, it actually was made in other parts of the country. In glazing their chinaware, the WIBA Chinese also used such colors as 7:30 p.m. TONITE



Germany seems to have been the first country in Europe where real porcelain was made. A little of it was turned out in the city of Dresden in 1709, and it came to be known as "Dresden china."

A year later, however, a factory was started at a smaller city, Meissen, which was closer to the spot where the clay was found. Meissen became the center of "Dresden china" for more than 200 years.

Knowledge of how to make porcelain spread to other parts of Europe. Much of it came to be made in France where "Sevres porcelain" grew famous.
