Actual War Photos Go On Display At Ohio Steel

An exhibit of actual war photographs, taken by combat photographers on all fighting fronts of the world during the past six months, will be placed on display Sunday at the Ohio Steel Foundry, and exhibited for two weeks for employees of the plant and members of their families.

The exhibit, composed of 100 prints, will be posted in the corridors of the personnel building, near the entrance. The prints were selected from thousands of thrilling action pictures made by fighting cameramen of the Air Force, Signal Corps, Navy, Marines and Coast Guard.

Employees of the plant have been urged to bring members of their family to view this latest edition of "Graflex Sees the War."

The pictures are presented by the Ohio Steel Foundry in cooperation with the Treasury Department. The exhibit was assembled by The Felmer Graflex Corp., of Rochester, N. Y., whose earlier war picture show during the

Fourth War Loan Drive was attended by three million persons in 200 cities.

Highlights of the new show are dramatic pictures of recent action in the South Pacific, photographs taken under enemy fire in the Italian campaign including late photographs of the Mt. Carmine sector and the devastating eruption of Mt. Vesuvius as well as pictures of new and powerful items of Army and Navy equipment in action. Far better than words can, these photographs portray the fierce, dogged purposefulness of combat.

There are few actual hor-

ror pictures in the exhibit, there are many which definitely show war to be the grim, tough and exacting struggle into which this conflict has evolved. The show is keyed to bring home a true realization of the conditions that our boys are up against, and to emphasize the necessity of our giving them all possible support thru continued war bond purchases and increased production.

"Graflex Sees the War" is one of those shows that no one can afford to miss.
