WLB ADOPTS BROAD VACATION POLICY

CLEVELAND, June 28—(UP)—The Regional War Labor Board announced today that it will base its future decisions on vacations on a broad policy of one week's vacation for workers with more than one and less than five years seniority and two weeks for workers with more than five years.

"The board's action," said Chairman Frederick L. Bullen, "is the result of a gradual growth of a policy over a period of many months. . . . The principles have been applied from time to time and found to meet the needs of both industry and of working men and women."

The board provided, however, that the employer may give extra pay in lieu of vacations when exceptional circumstances require continuous work, or where the vacation time taken will disturb the operation of the plant."

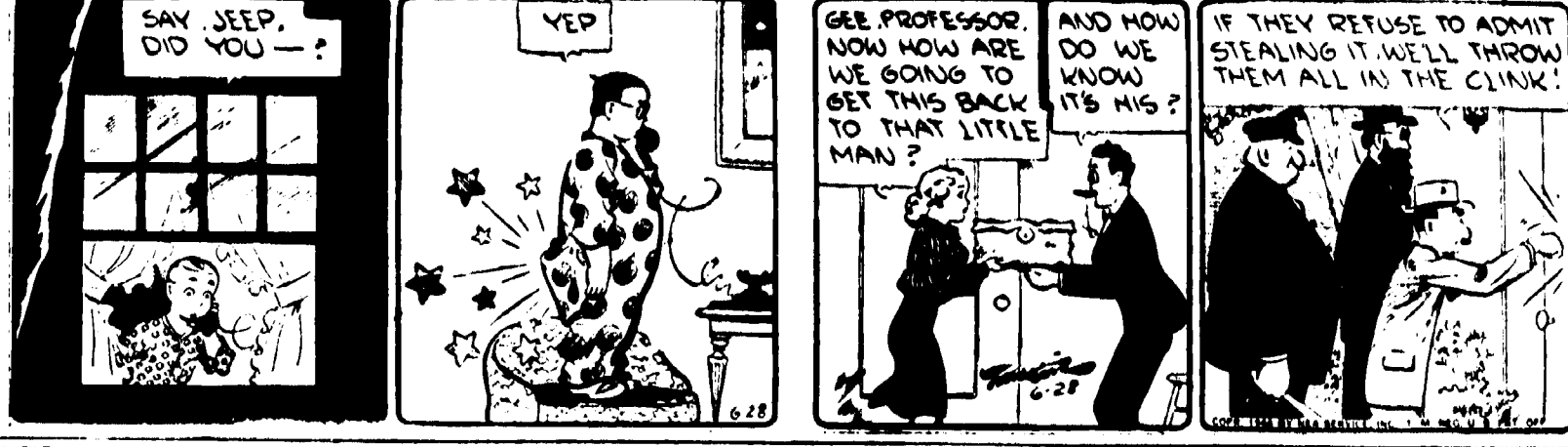

CLARIFICATION ASKED IN OHIO FOREST OFFER

CLEVELAND, June 28—(UP)—Don Farinacci, Chardon, O., lumberman, has written the attorney general requesting him to clarify "several ambiguities and uncertainties" in state control board's offer to purchase the Crile forest estate, it was disclosed today.

Attorney Gen. Thomas J. Herbert in his offer proposed that all of the Lake-co property formerly owned by the late Dr. George W. Crile and all of the timber on the

property at the time be turned over to the state for \$85,000.

Farinacci in his reply explained that only 81 per cent of the property which he obtained for \$81,000 last May belonged to Dr. Crile and that he since has constructed two sawmills and a logging road on the property and has been carrying on logging operations.

He added that it would be impossible to restore the property to its previous condition upon turning it over to the state and asked for a clarification of Herbert's offer. The offer expires Saturday.
