NEW ENGLAND LEADERS AND DEWEY CONFER

ALBANY, N. Y., July 11.—(INS)—Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York launched a series of conferences Monday with New England congressional leaders and candidates in the wake of increasing indications that most of the major supporters of Wendell L. Willkie, if not Willkie himself, will support his campaign for the presidency.

The governor returned to the executive mansion Sunday night, following a two-day stay at his Pawling farm home, to receive word that Samuel F. Pryor of Connecticut, Willkie's eastern campaign manager in 1940, had come out strongly for the New York governor and predicted that he would carry Connecticut next November.

The Republican presidential candidate had a heavy calendar Monday, featured by an afternoon conference with congressional leaders from Vermont, one of the two states which escaped the Roosevelt landslide in 1936, and dinner and evening conference with a delegation from Massachusetts, which promises to be a major political battleground through the campaign.

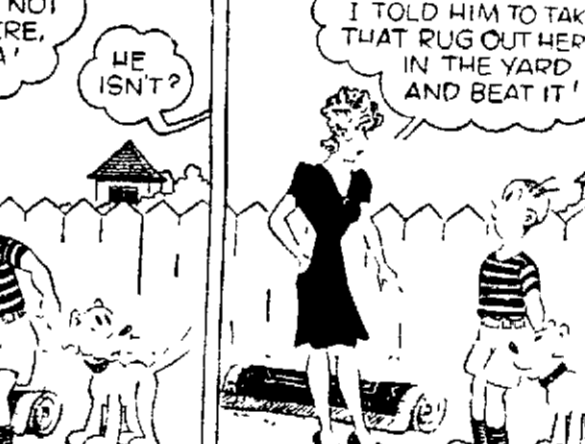

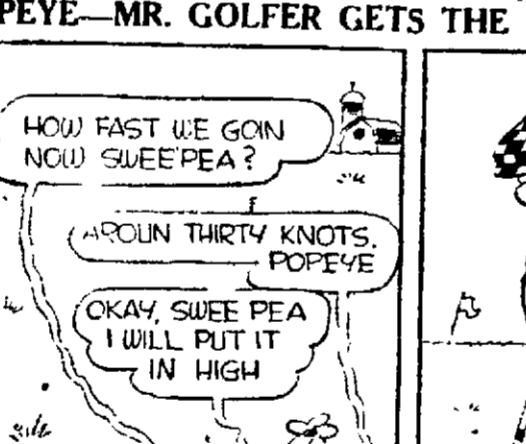

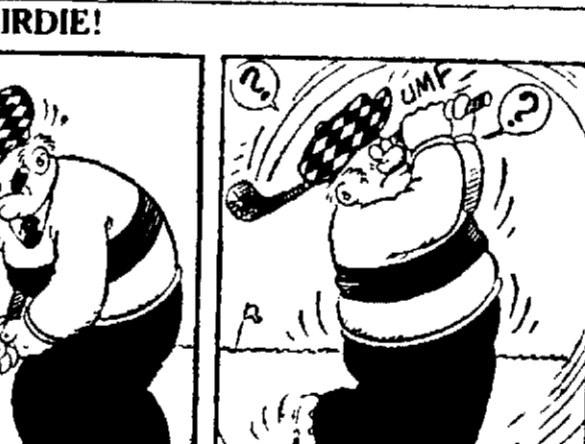
