WASHINGTON, July 29-(INS) · Organized labor today spearheaded demands that congress onact pending demobilization and postwar readjustment legislation

nt the earliest possible moment.

AFL President William Green warned that failure to provide economic safeguards in event of a sudden German coll**apse would** plunge the nation into chaos. He urged immediate passage of he Kilgoro postwar demobilization bill, which includes a sched-

ule of federal unemployment compensation for workers released by cuts in war production. Green said he had conferred with Sen. Robert Reynolds (D. NC.), chairman of the senate military affairs committee, on calling a committee meeting next Tues-

day morning to consider action on pending postwar bills. The economic outlook, monthly publication of the CIO, meanwhile, advocated early action on the Wagner-Murray-Dingell bill broadening the Social Security system as the initial phase in smoothing the demobilization process.
