"The Case of Kinnie Wagner," a dramatization of the life and crimes of the infamous hill-billy murderer and jail breaker who sported five notches in his gun belt, will be concluded on the "Gang Busters" broadcast, Friday at 9 p. m. over WJZ.

Fisher Bros. Organize New Detroit Firm

DETROIT, Aug. 4.—(INS)—Formation of a new manufacturing concern was announced today in Detroit by the four well-known Fisher brothers, whose retirement from the executive staff of General Motors was made known yesterday.

At a new conference, the brothers refused to comment on the nature of the material to be manufactured, but said activity would be centered in Detroit. They said the company would start operation after the war is over in Germany.

They stated, however, they felt that "after the war there will be a tremendous market for automobiles and room for many new auto manufacturing companies."

The brothers, William A., Lawrence P., Edward F., and Alfred J., said their only reason for covering connections with General Motors was a "desire to be associated again independently as brothers."

The Fishers became associated with General Motors in 1919 when the latter corporation purchased a controlling interest in the Fisher Body Corp.

The brothers also announced that the new company's president would be Charles T. Fisher, the oldest brother, who resigned from General Motors in 1934. He is now president of Fisher and Company.

In line with Fisher's retirement, C. E. Wilson, GM president, announced the appointment of Thomas P. Archer as general manager of the Fisher Body division.
