WORKER KILLED IN BLASTS AT POWDER PLANT

KINGS MILLS, O., Aug. 11.—(AP)—Four explosions at the King Powder Co. early today killed a worker identified as Woodrow Cornett. Two other men working nearby and a horse with which Cornett was working were not injured.

Kings Mills is in Warren-co., approximately 25 miles east of Cincinnati. The plant, which manufactures explosives, consists of a number of small wooden buildings in a wooded section along the Little Miami river.

Residents of Kings Mills said they heard one light blast, followed by three heavy explosions. The reports were said to have been heard 20 miles away.

Two wheel mills and two other interconnected buildings were reported damaged.
