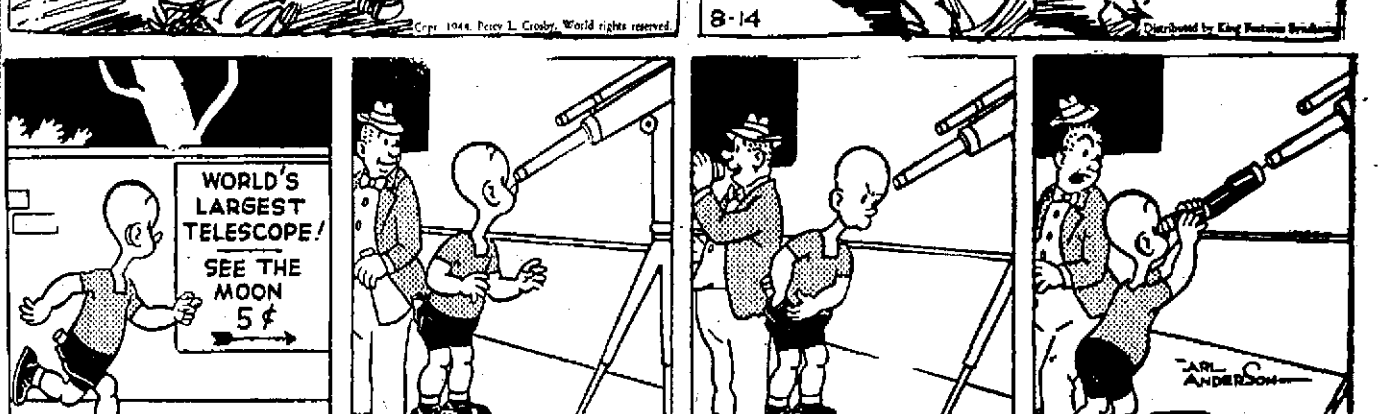
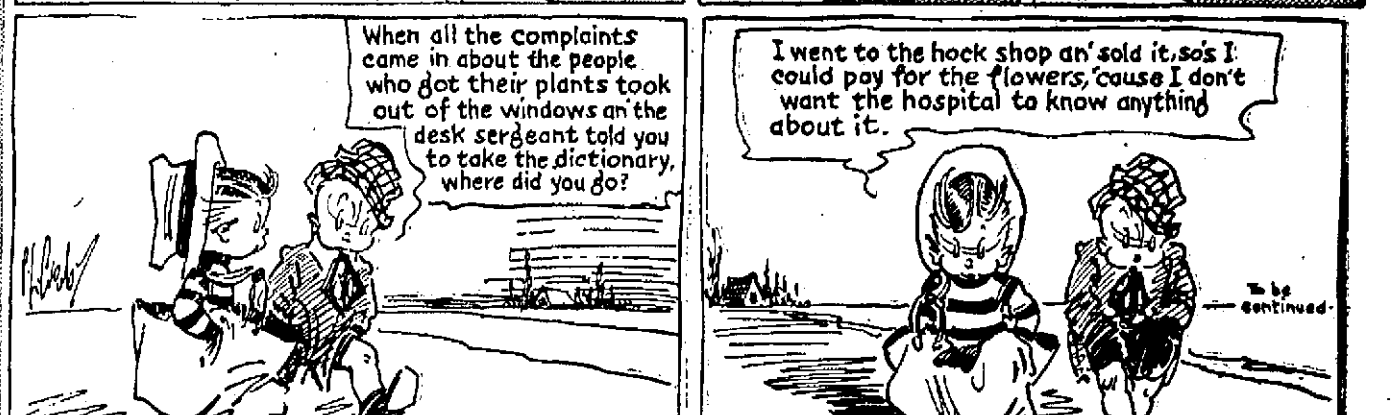
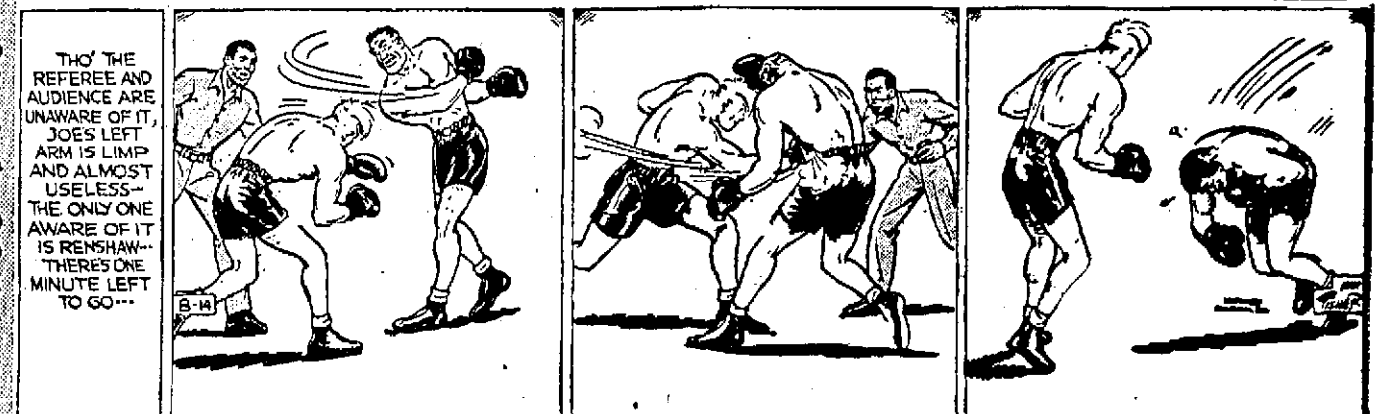

Uncle Ray's Corner SCOTT'S SCRAP BOOK By R. J. Scott. BABY OYSTERS HAVE POWER TO SWIM IN THE OCEAN. Did you ever see an oyster swim? Very likely not, and you may wonder why I ask such a question. Just about anyone knows that oysters are found on the sea bottom, and that they are enclosed in shells. How could such animals swim? The answer is that oysters cannot swim after they reach certain age. Yet there are small oysters which know how to get around in the water well enough! We may start the story with the eggs, and there are plenty of eggs in the oyster world. Take the British Columbia oyster as one example. At the age of four years it can produce 500,000 or 600,000 eggs in a season. At the age of seven, it is likely to produce 1,200,000 eggs. Fourteen thousand of those eggs, close together, would hardly cover the space of one square inch. The Canadian and American oyster may spawn from 50,000-100,000 to 60,000,000 eggs! The eggs are even smaller than those of British Columbian oysters. When an oyster egg hatches, a tiny animal — a larva — comes forth. In the case of Canadian and American oysters, these oyster larvae swim freely in the sea for only a day or two. The swimming time is much longer among British Columbian oysters and Australian mud oysters. The larvae leave the parent shells and swim about for about 10 days before they "settle down". As the years pass, oysters grow in size. Many of them are eaten by starfish, and they are attacked by other enemies as well. Small pests of one kind or another may get inside an oyster's shell. Sometimes these are tiny fish or tiny crabs. In this case the oyster's body throws a liquid around the invader, and the liquid hardens into a solid coat with a pearly color. Such an object, found in an oyster, is known as a "blister". Real pearls have been discovered inside blisters, but more often they contain nothing of value. Some men gamble by buying blisters from pearl divers or dealers in the hope of finding pearls, but usually they lose the money they have paid.
